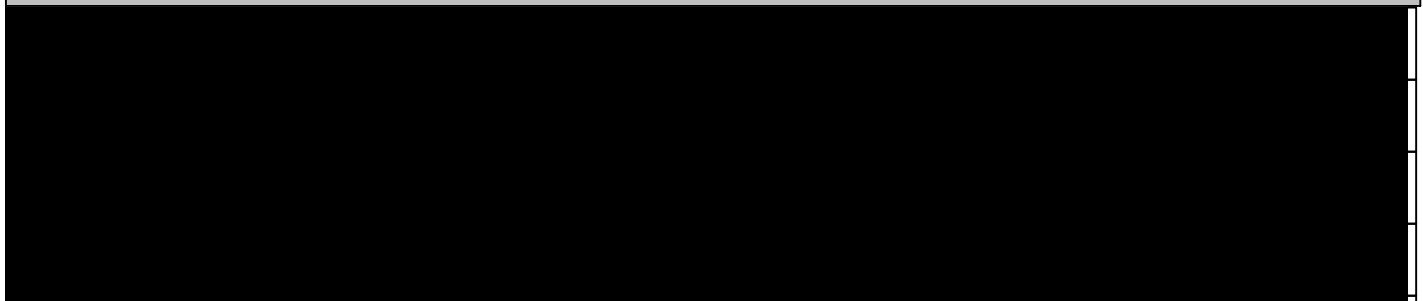

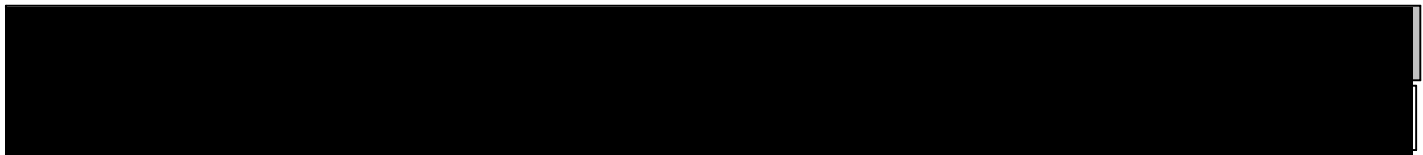
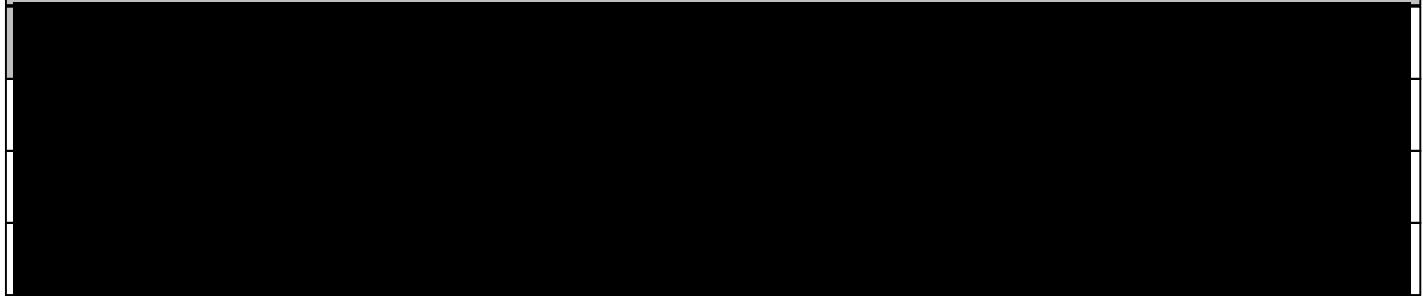

Notes/Narratives

On Monday November 2, 2015 [REDACTED], a counselor at Carl Sandberg Middle, called into report a possible child abuse. [REDACTED] advised me that the [REDACTED] teacher got emails from one of her students, [REDACTED], on Saturday. Due to the teacher not being in school she did not get the emails until this morning and she then sent them to [REDACTED]. The first email stated that her father hit her 4 times with a belt. She then went on to send emails saying that she did not want to be there anymore and asking for help. [REDACTED] contacted CPS which told her to call the police first.

I was then given [REDACTED]. When I arrived on scene there I spoke with [REDACTED] who answered the door. She advised me that her father was not home and he was at work. [REDACTED] went on to tell me that the emails were an accident. She stated that her [REDACTED] [REDACTED], who was not home got ahold of her phone and sent those emails as a joke. [REDACTED] seemed to be in good health and did not have any marks on her that would suggest an assault occurred.

When speaking with [REDACTED] I felt like she may have been nervous and uncomfortable with the police coming out to her house. I called [REDACTED] [REDACTED] back and advised her of what [REDACTED] had told me happened. I explained to her that I felt she may have been nervous speaking to police and she may be more forthcoming speaking with her or her [REDACTED] teacher if something did actually happen.
