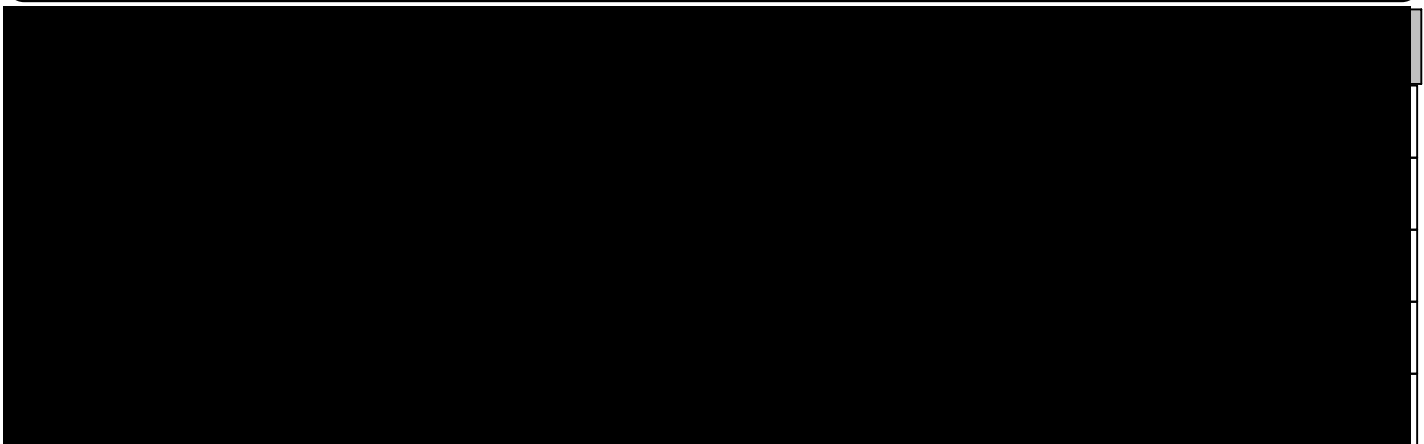

Notes/Narratives

On 12-9-15, [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] at his locker at the beginning of 2nd period wearing a winter coat and carrying his bookbag. [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] to put his coat and bookbag in his locker. [REDACTED] ignored [REDACTED] and walked away. [REDACTED] stopped him and asked him three more times to comply with the school rule. [REDACTED] was belligerent and disrespectful. [REDACTED] was asked three more times to hand over the bookbag/coat and [REDACTED] refused, claiming the school could not make him do this. [REDACTED] called for this unit (SRO) to assist him with [REDACTED]. This unit was able to get [REDACTED] to walk into [REDACTED] office along with School Security. [REDACTED] kept saying that he didn't care about any school policies or rules and didn't care if he was given a consequence. He refused multiple requests to hand over his coat and bookbag. [REDACTED] mom and explained to her the situation. [REDACTED] mom that the school would now need to search the bookbag and coat because of his hostile refusal to turn these two items over to school officials and potential threat to the safety of the school. [REDACTED] took the bookbag off [REDACTED] person. The bookbag was handed to [REDACTED] Security) and she stepped into the small conference room and searched it. [REDACTED] searched [REDACTED] jacket and found a cigarette, a lighter, and a silver canister containing trace amounts of what looked and smelled like marijuana. [REDACTED] stated it was his marijuana. [REDACTED] and Mr. [REDACTED] locker. Throughout this entire process [REDACTED] used inappropriate language, constantly disrespectful, and was uncooperative to multiple school officials.

School Security took pictures of the items collected from [REDACTED]. The canister and lighter was kept by the School for the Hearings Office. This unit took possession of the cigarette and it was packaged and stored at Station 2.

This unit will be filing a petition for possession of tobacco on school grounds.

[REDACTED] was notified of the school consequences and pending criminal charge. A copy of this report and Intake form was sent to JDC-Intake.
