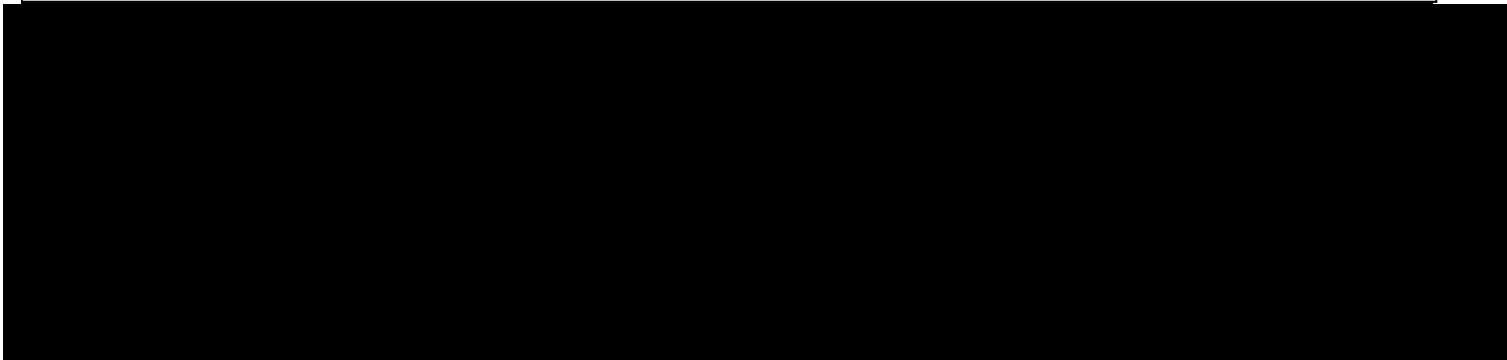

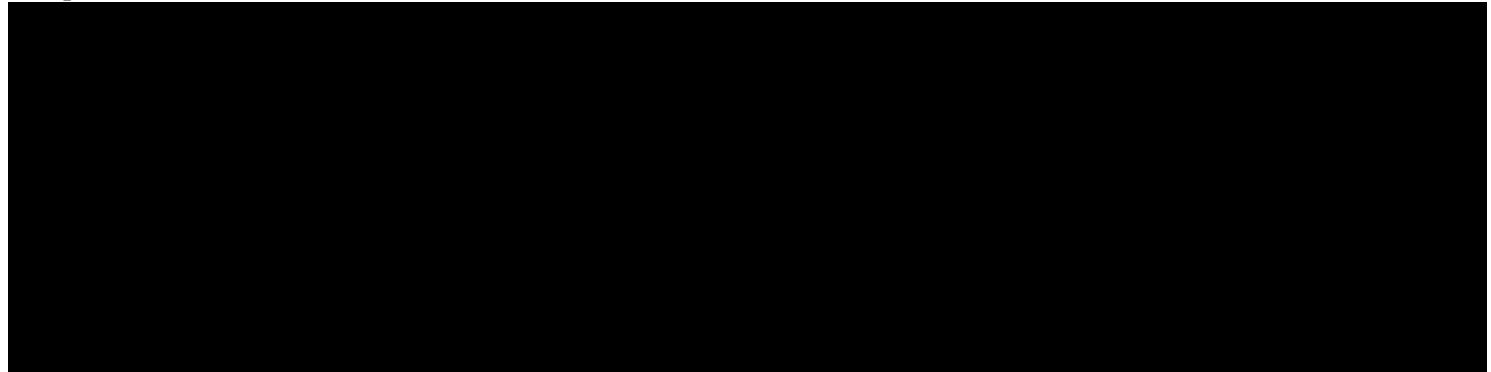

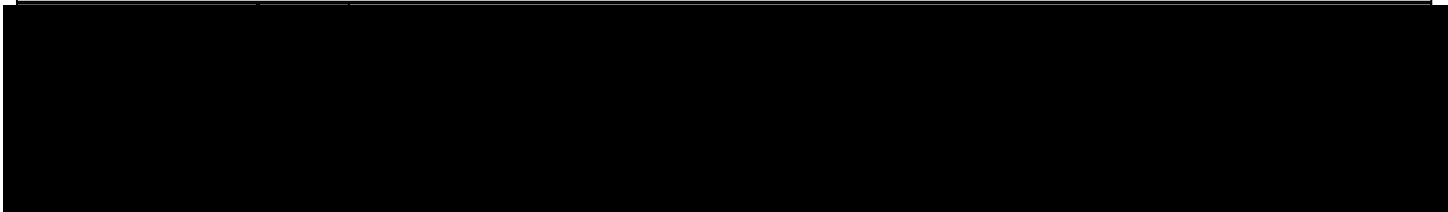

Notes/Narratives

On 5-17-16 around 0730 hours, security was called to the 400 hallway because there was a large crowd and a fight that teachers had just broken up. There were at least 30 kids still in the hallway watching this fight and 1st period had started and the principal was making his morning announcements. I found the victim, [REDACTED] room (451) and she was visibly upset, crying, and still shaking. [REDACTED] was holding her head and I could see there were [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] escorted [REDACTED] to her locker to grab her cell phone and then I walked her to the clinic. The other two females, [REDACTED], were taken to Student Services.

[REDACTED] stated that she was at her locker putting her phone away and [REDACTED] ran up to her and started punching her in the back of her head. [REDACTED] also was pulling her hair and pulled her hair with such force she pulled [REDACTED] down to the ground. [REDACTED] then started kicking her. [REDACTED] said another female, [REDACTED], ran up and started hitting and kicking her as well. [REDACTED] stated that over the last two weeks [REDACTED] would call her a bitch over a picture on Instagram. One of the comments on Instagram was [REDACTED] stating she was going to beat up [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] claimed that she heard people saying "Don't jump her", and she assumed that they were talking about [REDACTED] (her best friend) so she ran over there to the fight and began hitting [REDACTED] because she saw [REDACTED] hitting her.

[REDACTED] claimed that she was walking down the hallway with [REDACTED] bumped her shoulder. [REDACTED] stated that she took that action as she wanted to fight her so [REDACTED] began punching [REDACTED]

I spoke to another student who validated [REDACTED] story. This student, [REDACTED] heard [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] talking in the morning (during breakfast) saying they were going to fight today. [REDACTED] told them she wasn't going to be involved because she didn't want to get into trouble. Later as [REDACTED] was walking to class down the 400 hallway and she saw [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] locker. [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] punching [REDACTED] and pulling her hair. She also saw [REDACTED] punching [REDACTED]. Two teachers ran over to separate the girls. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] does not like [REDACTED] because of an argument over a picture on Instagram and [REDACTED] has been saying that she was going to fight [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] parents came to the school. They do not want to press charges for assault at this time, however I informed them that I was charging both girls that assaulted [REDACTED] with Disorderly Conduct. [REDACTED] parents took her to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] still had [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] due to the assault. She also had a [REDACTED] [REDACTED] still had [REDACTED]
