







Notes/Narratives

During the first week of March I was notified by Security and [REDACTED] that there was an assault that took place on 2-29-16 in room 622. In theatre class [REDACTED] (7th grader - witness) was talking to [REDACTED] (victim) and all of a sudden [REDACTED] (offender/arrested) walked over to [REDACTED] and pushed her against the wall and then grabbed her around her neck. [REDACTED] began choking her and [REDACTED] tried to get him off of her but she was not able to do so. [REDACTED] sees this assault and goes over to help get [REDACTED] off of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED]'s face was visibly red. This assault was immediately reported to the [REDACTED] and School Security was called.

[REDACTED] father was contacted and informed me that he wanted to press charges.

[REDACTED] was notified by [REDACTED] of the incident. [REDACTED] came to Sandburg on 3-2-16 around 1000hours to meet with myself and [REDACTED] regarding the assault. I informed [REDACTED] that the victim's family wants to press assault charges. I asked [REDACTED] to explain what took place on 2-29-16. [REDACTED] stated that he was upset that [REDACTED] blocked him from Snapchat and Instagram. He stated he was trying to talk to her and she was ignoring him. He said he tries to talk to [REDACTED] everyday and she is always telling him to leave her alone.

I spoke to [REDACTED] and she stated that [REDACTED] has been following her and bothering her since the end of November. [REDACTED] has followed her around school and to her locker. He tries to watch her open up her locker and see what her combination is. [REDACTED] asked him to stop and leave her alone but he would just stay there and stare at her. [REDACTED] has witnessed [REDACTED] stand by her locker and try to say "bye" to her. [REDACTED] does not respond and this makes [REDACTED] mad. A student reported this behavior to her counselor early February, but [REDACTED] said nothing was done and his behavior only got worse and more physical. [REDACTED] would follow her around school saying, "I love you." One day while [REDACTED] was walking to gym class with [REDACTED] (witness) and [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to stop following her around. [REDACTED] got mad and dipped his shoulder into [REDACTED] causing her to lose balance and hit the wall. She was not injured. [REDACTED] said, [REDACTED] - what are you doing?". Another day during gym the students were going back to the locker rooms and [REDACTED] said to [REDACTED] (witness), "Watch this." [REDACTED] proceeded to pull [REDACTED] ponytail causing her body to lean back, almost falling backwards. [REDACTED] also witnessed [REDACTED] push [REDACTED] with his shoulder (again) into the wall. There was one day during 6th period class that [REDACTED] was sitting behind [REDACTED] and he would touch her hair and back during class. [REDACTED] asked him several times to stop. A female student, [REDACTED], witnessed this interaction. On 2/22/16 or 2/23/16 [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] choked her in [REDACTED] (1st time). This time [REDACTED] put one hand around her neck trying to choke her, but she was able to get him off immediately. [REDACTED] had a test next class and didn't get a chance to tell her counselor but she did tell [REDACTED].

After speaking to all the witnesses I gave each of them a business card to give to their parents and to make sure they are aware of what happened at school. I received a few emails and phone calls from parents showing their support.

I will send this report and the Intake form to Juvenile Intake for processing. Nothing further at this time.
