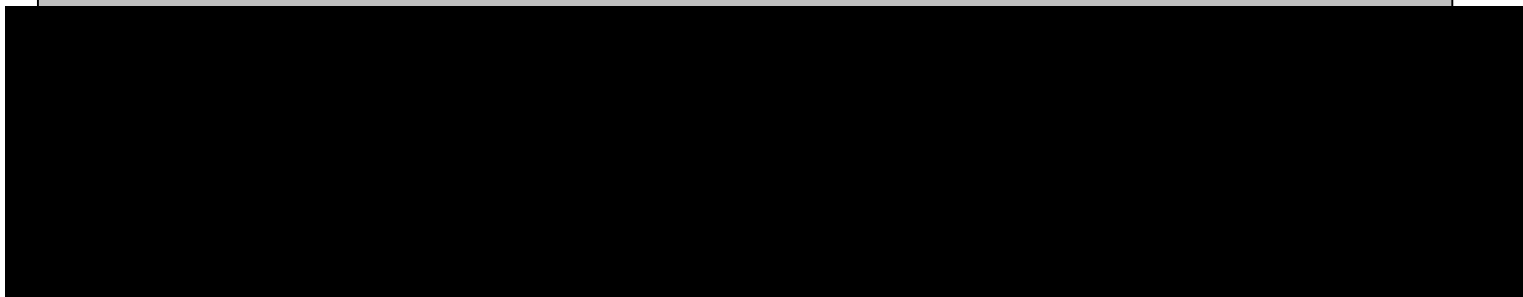

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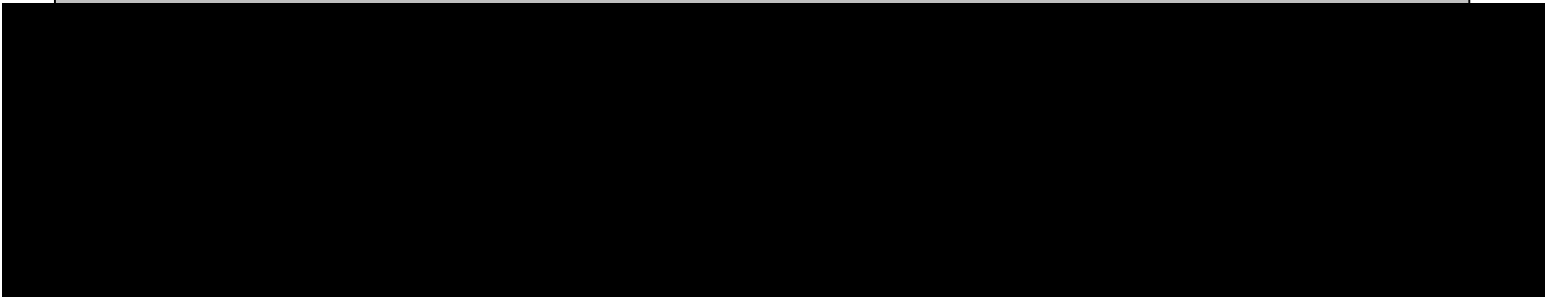
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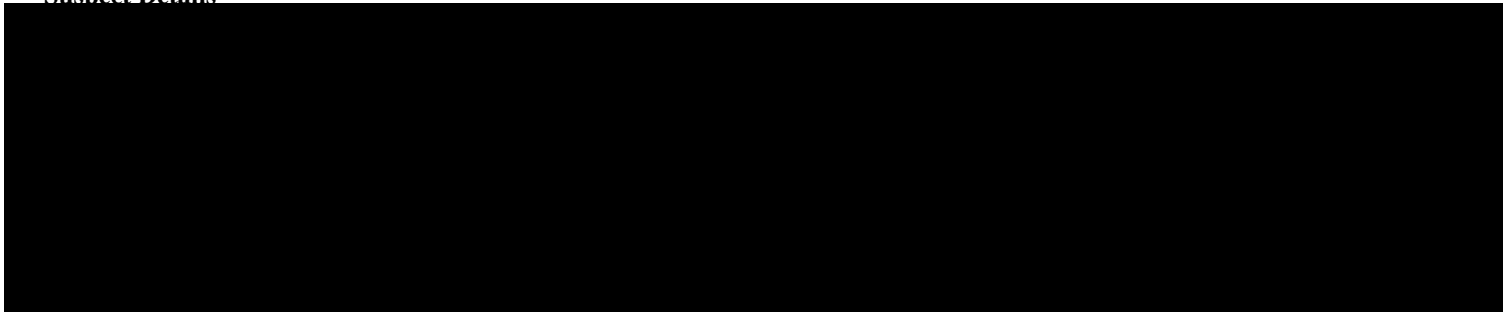

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Notes/Narratives

On 4-4-16, around 1300 hours [REDACTED] (victim) came to my office to report that someone stole her cell phone. [REDACTED] had her cell phone in her bag next to her during 1st period. [REDACTED] (room 422) for 1st period. [REDACTED] is positive that she had her phone when she walked into 1st period. She realized that it was gone during 2nd period. [REDACTED] checked around the school and asked a few friends if they had seen her cell phone. [REDACTED] (school security) talked to a few students from 1st period to see if they witnessed anything. Negative results. [REDACTED] and I tried to find her iphone using the find your iphone app but the phone was "offline". I suggested that [REDACTED] attempt to track it after school to see if whoever has the phone turns it back on and is able to get an address. [REDACTED] said around 1830 hours she checked and the phone was turned on. The app showed that the phone was at [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and her mom went to that address and they were able to recover the iphone. However, the phone case was missing. The male student that had the stolen phone was, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and her mom that a female student, [REDACTED], gave him the phone in school.

On 4-5-16 [REDACTED] informed me that they want to press charges.

I spoke to [REDACTED] during 8th period on 4-5-16. [REDACTED] told me that during 3rd period [REDACTED] class she asked to use the bathroom. There is a bathroom right next to her class on the 1st floor, but she decided that she needed to go to her locker (upstairs) as well. [REDACTED] claimed that when she walked into the bathroom upstairs she saw "some" other female student in there using her phone and that she noticed another phone sitting on top of the paper towel dispenser. [REDACTED] then said that she used the bathroom and when she went to wash her hands she noticed the phone was gone and the other student. [REDACTED] could not describe this student. [REDACTED] also mentioned that around 4th period she overheard [REDACTED] talking to a group of people that was missing her phone. I asked [REDACTED] to give me some names of the students that were around and she was unable to. After a few fabricated stories, she finally told me that she was the one that stole the phone. [REDACTED] admitted to going into [REDACTED] bag and stealing the phone. [REDACTED] stated that she was talking with [REDACTED] in 7th period and [REDACTED] asked her whose phone she had in her hands. [REDACTED] told him it belonged to [REDACTED] [REDACTED] then told her he could wipe the phone clean for her. [REDACTED] the phone. [REDACTED] admitted to throwing the phone case in the trash can upstairs.

The parent liaison, [REDACTED] mom (4-5-16 around 1500 hours) to inform her of the situation and the pending larceny charges. [REDACTED] mom came to the school on 4-6-16 around 0720 hours because she had a few more questions about the process.

I spoke to [REDACTED] and he claimed that [REDACTED] gave him the phone (he knew it was not [REDACTED] infact [REDACTED] told him it belonged to [REDACTED] during 7th period and asked him to wipe it clean. [REDACTED] took the phone home. He told me that he did not do anything with the phone and planned to give it back to [REDACTED] on 4-5-16. However he turned it on and also when [REDACTED] got the phone back she could tell the wrong password was put in wrong to many times.

I also had the parent liaison call [REDACTED] parents to inform them of the situation and the pending charge (possession of stolen property).

I submitted the report and Intake form to Juvenile Intake for processing. Nothing further at this time.
