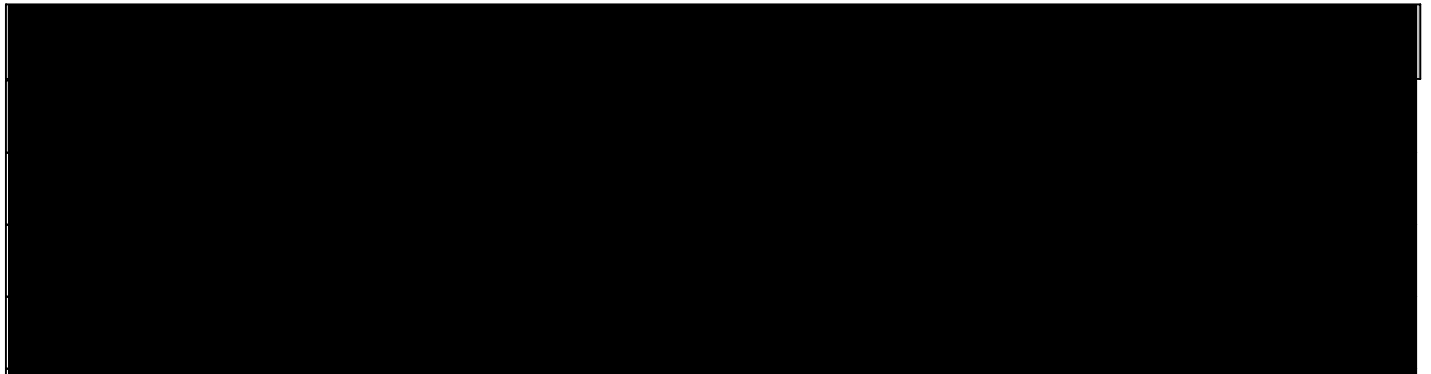

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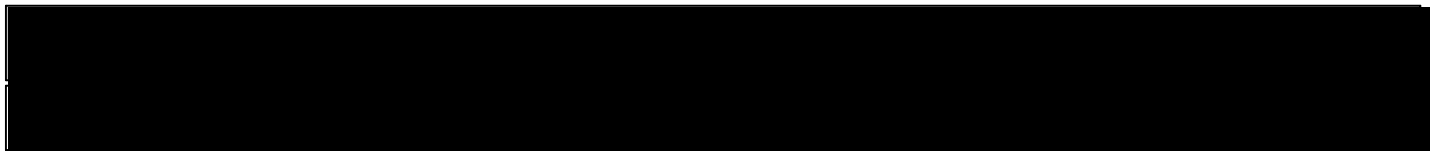
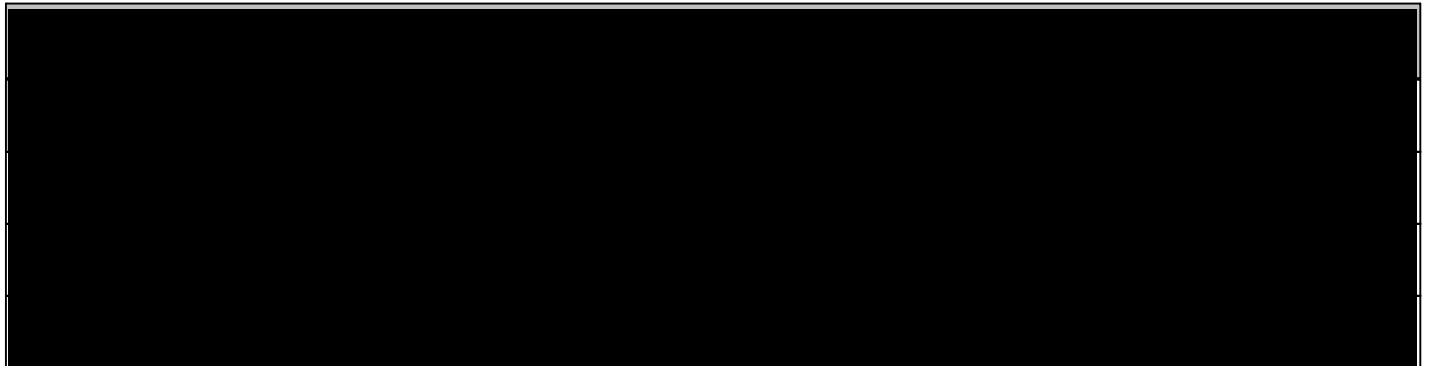

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Notes/Narratives

On 4-20-16 I responded the front office of the school where I met with a CPS worker [REDACTED] and she told me that she received a report of potential child abuse from the school counselor [REDACTED]. A female student (7th grader), [REDACTED] reported that on 4-18-16 her mother [REDACTED] beat her up over an issue with a cell phone. [REDACTED] stated that on monday she got in trouble with her mom because her mom found out she borrowed a friend's cell phone. [REDACTED] does not like [REDACTED] borrowing things from other people. [REDACTED] got upset and told [REDACTED] to get on her knees and then she kicked her in the stomach. Next [REDACTED] took a phone cord and hit [REDACTED] multiple times all over her body. [REDACTED] begged for her mom to stop hitting her. [REDACTED] then dragged [REDACTED] on the carpet causing rug burns on her left elbow. The rug burn was about the size of a quarter. She received these burns because she was trying to get away from her mom while she was dragging her on the carpet. There was also a faint mark/abrasion on her right arm. During this assault [REDACTED] step father, [REDACTED] was sitting on the couch and did nothing to stop the assault. There was also a [REDACTED] [REDACTED] present in the house however he was in his bedroom during the time of the assault. This assault took place in the living room around 1800 hours.

[REDACTED] stated that her mom beat her up three months ago using a belt on her back. [REDACTED] told CPS that she is afraid of her mother. [REDACTED] went to school on 4-19-16 (tuesday) but did not go home that night. She stayed at a friend's house tuesday night. [REDACTED] has been in the states with her mom for only two years. They are from El Salvador. [REDACTED] has been in the states for about 10 years and apparently talked to [REDACTED] over the phone approximately every seven days (while [REDACTED] was still living in El Salvador). [REDACTED] was raised by her paternal grandmother [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that she was mad that her daughter lied about a cell phone and referred to her as a "rebel". [REDACTED] admitted to hitting [REDACTED] with a phone cord several times. She also admitted that she kicked and hit her daughter while dragging her on the carpet. [REDACTED] was very calm while being questioned about the assault almost as if she didn't care or think it was an issue. [REDACTED] acknowledged that she hit [REDACTED] in the past with a belt. [REDACTED] stated that she has never hit her son.

The CPS worker took pictures of [REDACTED]. CPS talked with [REDACTED] at length about appropriate discipline. [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

I placed [REDACTED] under arrest for Domestic Assault and she was handcuffed (in the front [REDACTED]). I searched her and then placed her in the back of my cruiser and transported her to Mount Vernon station to meet with a magistrate. [REDACTED] issued a warrant for Domestic Assault and issued an EPO. The EPO only specified "no further acts of violence". The Deputies processed [REDACTED] and then she was PR'd. During this entire process I had an interpreter with us [REDACTED] CPS and the interpreter took both [REDACTED] home and they established a safety plan. CPS will follow up with the step father and son. The step-father was not available during this time as he was at work in MD.

A copy of the EPO was faxed to TTY. It was entered by operator #319090 and the TTY# is 16-11100032. I served [REDACTED] her copy at approximately 1628 hours. I gave [REDACTED] (victim) her copy at approximately 1700 hours. [REDACTED] entered the LOI as well made a note for officers that respond to the home address in the future to use "universal precautions".

Case closed - Arrest.
