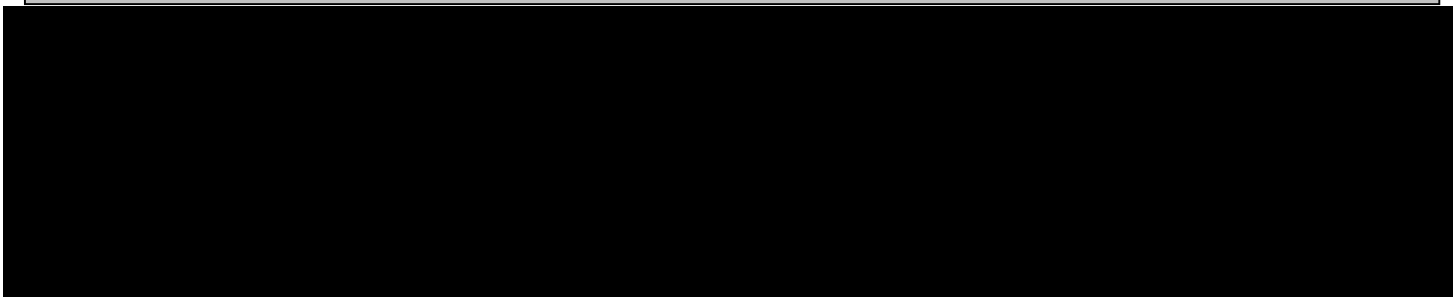

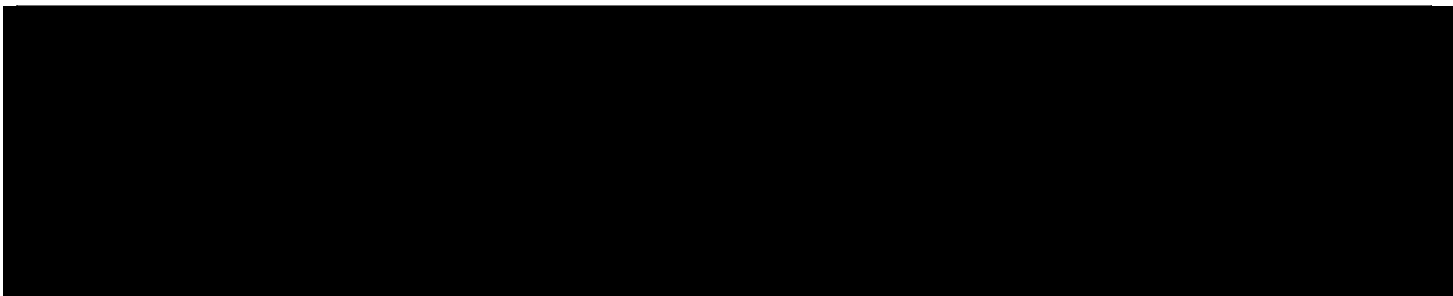

Notes/Narratives

I was notified on 5-13-16 that an 8th grader, [REDACTED], had a folding pocket knife and pepper spray in his book bag. [REDACTED] brought these items to school on 5-10-16. Earlier in the day, [REDACTED] bookbag was taken by Student Services and placed in the front office. [REDACTED] went home that day and his bookbag remained in the front office. These items were discovered during the after school sessions by [REDACTED] (custodian). [REDACTED] moved the bookbag while cleaning and he heard a strange noise. He opened the bookbag and discovered the pepper spray and he looked in another pocket and that is when he discovered the knife. He immediately contacted [REDACTED] (After School Specialist). [REDACTED] brought the bookbag to [REDACTED] (AP).

[REDACTED] claimed that the knife was left in his bookbag following a Boy Scouts outing back in December and the pepper spray belonged to his mom, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she threw the pepper spray away following an incident in her home where [REDACTED] used the pepper spray indoors in close proximity to his [REDACTED]. His actions caused a recation and the [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] later found the pepper spray in the trash can and put it in his bookbag (without his mother's knowledge). [REDACTED] claims he received a text message on 5-9-16 from an unknown number that said "you will get shot at school." He claims he immediately blocked that number. And it so happened that [REDACTED] to Sprint to get a new phone that same day. Sprint re-set that phone. [REDACTED] did not save the metxt ssage and did not tell anyone when he received the message. He said he felt threatened which is why he brought the pepper spray to school on 5-10-16.

[REDACTED] was suspended from school for 10 days. I sent the Intake Form and Report to Juvenile Intake for processing. [REDACTED] is currently on probation and I notified his Probation Officer.

The pocket knife and pepper spray were packaged and stored as evidence at Station 2.
