### Notes/Narratives

On 5-24-16, School Security and this Unit were called to the 7th grade Girl's Locker room. There was a report of three stolen phones and two stolen headphones. The P.E. teachers held the entire class. School Security searched every student and their locker. Related cases are 20161450210, 20161470184, and 20161530108.

The last person to be searched by School Security was [REDACTED] I have two witnesses [REDACTED] that both saw [REDACTED] take a rose gold iphone and a Samsung phone, this information was given to this unit after [REDACTED] was sent back to class. Security went to [REDACTED] 8th period class around 1410 hours and brought [REDACTED] to this unit's office. [REDACTED] claims she did not take any phones and would not talk to [REDACTED] his unit any further. She became belligerent while in the office and stormed out of the office towards the buses. [REDACTED] has not returned to school since 5-24-16. This unit discovered that [REDACTED] was arrested on 5-31-16 for assaulting a cab driver and has been placed in the Juvenile Court Shelter Care II School. [REDACTED] mom or dad have not returned my phone call.

One witness, [REDACTED], stated that while she and three other female students were in the locker room unattended she observed [REDACTED] looking through bags in the locker room. She observed [REDACTED] find a gold iphone but said, "I don't want this." and put it back. Next, [REDACTED] found a Samsung phone inside a pencil pouch and took that phone. Then [REDACTED] found a pink (rose gold) iphone and hid that inside the front of her pants.

A Second witness, [REDACTED] steal a rose gold iphone and a Samsung phone. [REDACTED] gave [REDACTED] the Samsung phone in the locker room when the girls were inside unattended. [REDACTED] admitted to taking the stolen phone home, but brought it back to school on 5-26-16.

The Samsung phone was recovered and returned to the owner, however all the contents on the phone was erased. The victim and her mom want to press charges.

This report and the Intake form was sent to Juvenile Intake for processing.

### Supplement Notes

On 9-13-16, I was advised that the defendant/offender [REDACTED] has been harassing/threatening one of my witnesses [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] came to my office and told me that after school on 9-12-16 [REDACTED] walked up to her and told her that she was going to fight her tomorrow after school. [REDACTED] told her that she was not going to fight her. [REDACTED] told her that she wanted to fight her because "on the paper it said she stole two phones." [REDACTED] was afraid to walk in school alone. Her school counselor and I notified her teachers and gave her permission to leave each class 2-3 minutes early so she can get to her next class safely. I also notified [REDACTED] father and I suggested that an adult meet [REDACTED] at the bus stop or they could pick her up at school. I notified the Commonwealth Attorney's Office as well.

Also during the day I observed my second witness [REDACTED] acting out of character. While walking the halls [REDACTED] saw me and said, [REDACTED] "I am not going to come to court tomorrow." I told her she needs to and if she has any issues she needs to come to me and we can talk about it. I also noticed [REDACTED] was not walking with her normal group of friends. The AIA admin took [REDACTED] to talk with the principal. Then at the end of the day out at bus duty [REDACTED] walked up to [REDACTED] and said, "So are you going to court tomorrow?" [REDACTED] was standing next to [REDACTED] when this took place. [REDACTED] did not say a word and just got onto her bus.
