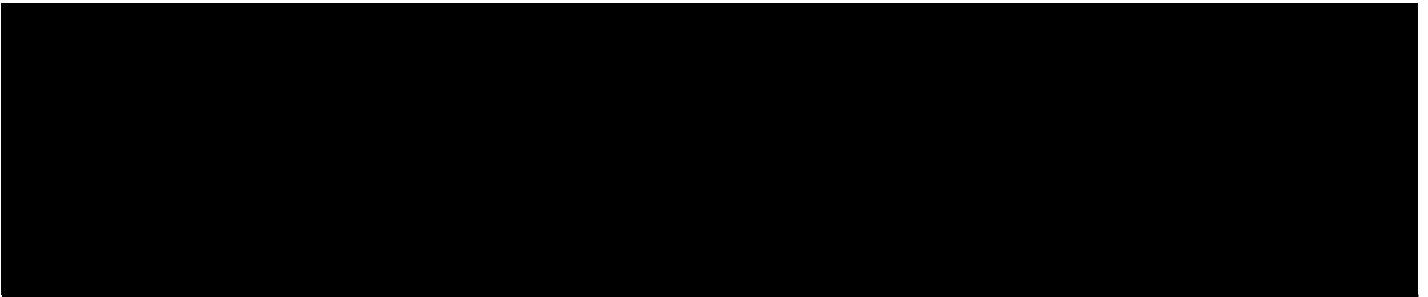

Notes/Narratives

On 6/15/2016 I was on patrol at the Carl Sandburg School located at 8428 Fort Hunt Rd. There, I encountered a vehicle backed in between two buses. I would identify the driver to be [REDACTED] and the back seat passenger to be [REDACTED]. While speaking with both subjects, I could smell an odor of marijuana from within the vehicle.

I had [REDACTED] step out who would consent to search with nothing of note found. Because I was alone at the time, [REDACTED] was detained and placed in my cruiser. I then had [REDACTED] step out. I informed [REDACTED] that I would be searching the vehicle due to the odor of marijuana and asked "what am I going to find?" She said there was a little bit of weed in the front passenger floorboard and that it was [REDACTED]. The vehicle was searched after additional units arrived. Marijuana in a plastic bag was found exactly where [REDACTED] said it would be. Nothing else noteworthy found.

[REDACTED] was read Miranda Rights, which he understood. I told [REDACTED] I found the marijuana and asked who it belonged to. He said "its mine." [REDACTED] was cited without incident for possession of marijuana and provided a test for chemical analysis form.

The marijuana later tested positive via a NARK II test kit, Lot #201410081. It was packaged and stored as evidence at the Mount Vernon Locker. No further action taken.
