Notes/Narratives

I responded to the intersection of Old Stage Rd and Stockade Dr and made contact with the complainant, [REDACTED] at Carl Sanburg MS, in reference to an incident that had just occurred at the middle school.

[REDACTED] stated he was leaving the school, out of one of the doors facing Fort Hunt Rd, to go to his car. As he was walking, he passed a group of five students, one female and four males, who began yelling at him; [REDACTED] states he only knew one of the boy's first name, [REDACTED] but recognized the other students as seventh or eighth graders. [REDACTED] also states that all of the students were hispanic, like him, and digressed to explain he tries to inspire his hispanic students not to act out due to their ethnicity because they should be treated according to their behavior, not their skin color. [REDACTED] continued that as he was walking past the group of students, they began saying curse words to him in spanish, and at one point, one of the students said, "T'm going to get you fag," in spanish. [REDACTED] initially reported the phrase in spanish, and clarified that the above quote is the closest english translation.

[REDACTED] did not seem upset by the incident or the language used as he explained he is used to high school students. [REDACTED] advised he knew one of the students was already assigned to a probation officer, and didn't mind if that student got into trouble for the incident, but did not want the others to get into any kind of trouble.

Per [REDACTED] would be familiar with the students but he did not have any further information on them with him at the time. [REDACTED] did not wish to pursue the report further as it was the last day of school, but did state he would be available if the SRO wanted anymore information from him.
