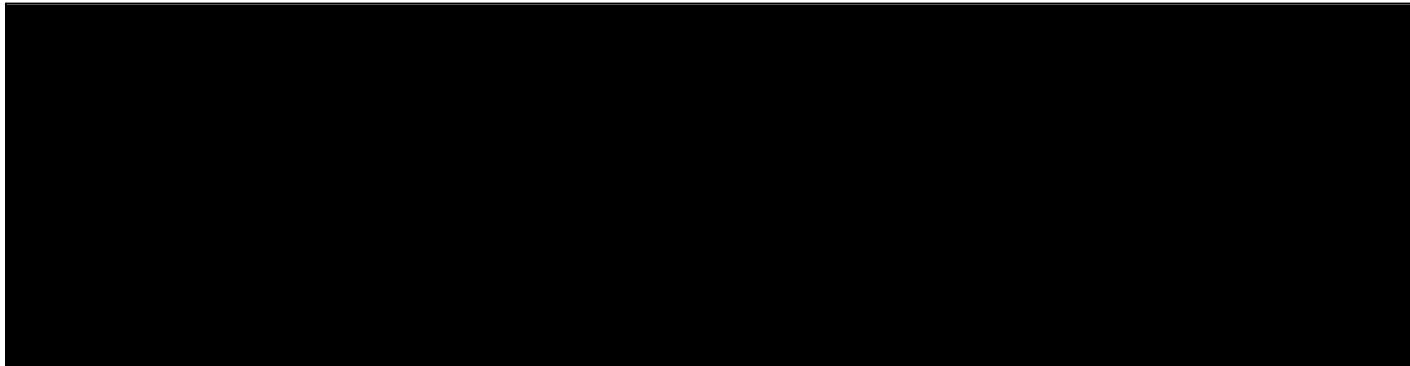

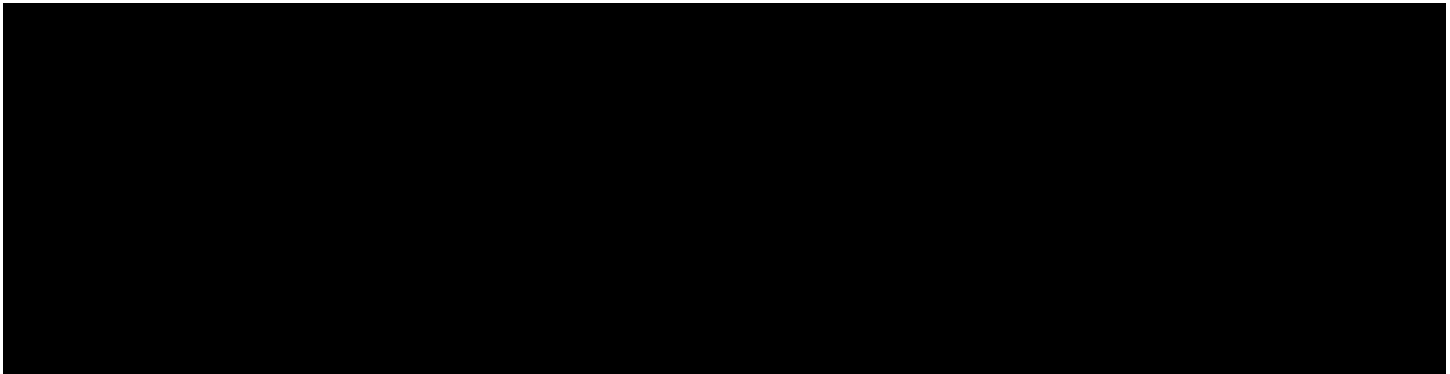

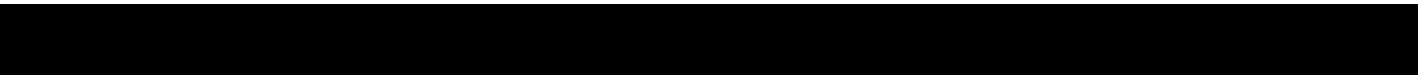

### Notes/Narratives

On 9-8-16, this unit was in the hallway before first period began assisting students with finding their classrooms. A PE teacher [REDACTED] called for this unit to assist him with a student. This unit immediately knew the student he was referring to and this unit asked that student [REDACTED] to stop. [REDACTED] stopped and this unit then asked the teacher what is going on.

[REDACTED] stated that he was upstairs helping another student open her locker. And while they were walking down the hallway he observed [REDACTED] and her "crew" walking down the hallway towards him. [REDACTED] was yelling and cursing down the hallway while skipping backwards and forward. [REDACTED] had a student he was helping on his right side and there was nowhere for him to move due to other students in the halls. [REDACTED] then purposely bumped her shoulder into [REDACTED]. She immediately starred him down (head to toe) and waved her finger in front of his face. [REDACTED] asked her to stop and she took off running downstairs. [REDACTED] continued to assist the other student with her locker. Then about 3-4 minutes later [REDACTED] was downstairs and saw [REDACTED] again and asked her to stop again. [REDACTED] refused and took off running (again) up stairs. [REDACTED] slowly walked away and apparently [REDACTED] thought [REDACTED] was gone so she came back downstairs and proceeded to speed walk towards the gym. [REDACTED] then saw this unit down the hallway and requested assistance. This unit was able to have [REDACTED] stop. [REDACTED] has no reason to be upstairs. Her first class is downstairs as well as her locker. [REDACTED] claims he bumped into her. She stated that after the contact she yelled at him, "What the hell". She told this unit she thought that teacher was a student. The teacher does not look like a student at all. This unit called for her Administrator and they took [REDACTED] to the front office.

[REDACTED] came to this unit's office during 3rd period when he had a free moment. [REDACTED] wants to press charges. This unit explained the program AAP to him and he agreed that would be a good option for this situation. [REDACTED] behavior has gotten worse over the last 10 months and the school has not been able handle her behavior.

This unit called and spoke to [REDACTED] mom on 9-8-16 around 0945 hours. This unit explained the situation the took place this morning and the AAP program.

The AAP referral was sent for processing. Nothing further at this time.
