I responded to [REDACTED] for a report of an assault. The assault occurred near the intersection of Audubon Ave/Janna Lee Ave. [REDACTED] advised that her daughter was assaulted after she got off the bus and started to walk home. [REDACTED] said as she started home she saw the suspects. They called to her to come over to them and [REDACTED] did. S1, who she knows as [REDACTED] said I want to fight you, put your stuff down. [REDACTED] said she told her no and turned to walk away. She said one of the suspects then grabbed her by her hair and they both punched her multiple times. A boy (unknown name) that was there along with a unknown adult female told the suspects to stop. One of the girls said she snitched on us and then they walked away. [REDACTED] said she then went home and told her mom what happen. [REDACTED] advised this incident was because [REDACTED], who is only known as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] (SRO for Sandburg) was aware of what the situation was over. [REDACTED]. They both ride the same school bus as [REDACTED]. She said they both were on the bus this morning but neither road the bus home. [REDACTED] said she believes one of the suspects lives at [REDACTED] Myself and [REDACTED] attempted to make contact there with no answer. Prior to clearing [REDACTED] who she believed witnessed the assault. I spoke with [REDACTED] and he advised he did not see how the fight started. He did see two B/F's assaulting [REDACTED]. He did not know their names but said they do ride the bus to school with them. Case held active, info copy [REDACTED]

Supplement Notes

On 9-26-16, this unit was informed of a fight that took place at the bus stop after school on 9-23-16. The front office notified this unit that the mother of [REDACTED] (7th grader) called the school on Friday (9-23-16) around 1510 hours to inform them that her daughter witnessed [REDACTED] getting beat up by two other girls. [REDACTED] mother mentioned the name [REDACTED] but did not mention the other girl's name.

Around 1000 hours on 9-26-16, [REDACTED] (8th grader) and her mother came to the school to talk to this unit about pressing charges for assault. [REDACTED] stated the following took place on Friday: She got off Bus [REDACTED] and began to walk home. [REDACTED] said she walks home a slightly longer way because two students have threatened her recently. As she was walking home [REDACTED] (8th grader) called her over and said, "You still told the school I wanted to fight you, so I am going to give you a chance to drop your stuff, or if you don't I am gonna just go up to you." [REDACTED] told them she does not want to fight and turned away to walk home. At that point, one of the girls grabbed her by the hair so she would turn around and [REDACTED] tried to punch whoever it was that pulled her hair. [REDACTED] was not sure if she hit anyone. She then fell to the ground and covered her face. Both girls were punching [REDACTED] all over her body. [REDACTED] heard an unidentified male voice telling the girls to stop or "cool out" several times, but [REDACTED] (8th grader) didn't stop until some adults arrived. [REDACTED] provided this unit with 6 names of witnesses that observed the assault. [REDACTED] ride bus [REDACTED] arrived to the neighborhood a few minutes before Bus [REDACTED]. This is why [REDACTED] were already in the neighborhood waiting (behind the leasing office) for [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] (7th grader - witness #1) stated that he was walking home with two of his friends when they saw [REDACTED] on the ground being punched and possibly kicked by two B/F's. He did not know the names of the two females, but was able to identify [REDACTED] from a student directory picture. Later in the day, [REDACTED] was walking with [REDACTED] (the principal) and [REDACTED] was able to identify [REDACTED] in the hallways as the second person involved in the assault.

[REDACTED] (7th grader - witness #2) stated that she rides bus [REDACTED] and that on Friday while walking home she saw two girls beating up another girl. She also pointed out there was a B/M standing nearby that was cheering them on. [REDACTED] looked in the student directory and identified one of the girls as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] (7th grader - witness #3) also rode bus [REDACTED] and said she was walking home with friends on Friday and noticed two girls punching [REDACTED], who was on the ground. [REDACTED] stated that a male student, [REDACTED], was standing a few feet away watching the fight. [REDACTED] also mentioned that the two girls only stopped when an adult came over to help [REDACTED] was shown pictures in the student directory and identified one of the girls as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] (8th grader - witness #4) stated that he rides bus [REDACTED] but repeatedly said that he did not witness a fight. He stated that he was walking home on Friday (alone) and did notice [REDACTED] on the ground and it looked like she had just been beaten up and her glasses were broken. [REDACTED] said he saw two adults nearby calling the Police.

[REDACTED] (7th grader - witness #5) said that she rides [REDACTED] and was walking home with [REDACTED] on Friday. [REDACTED] said she does not have a good memory, but she remembers seeing a girl being beat up by two other girls. She saw the two B/F's pulling a Spanish girl's hair. [REDACTED] was able to identify the Spanish girl as [REDACTED] by looking through pictures. [REDACTED] stated she does not know the other two girls.

[REDACTED] (7th grader - witness #6) said that she was walking home with friends on Friday and witnessed [REDACTED] being beat up by two other girls. [REDACTED] mentioned that one of the girls she saw was [REDACTED] and did not know the second girl's name.

This unit spoke with [REDACTED] who claimed she did not see a fight or do anything wrong on Friday. She kept asking what happened. When it was

explained to [REDACTED] that a girl had been beaten up at the bus stop and her glasses were broken, she laughed and said, "I had nothing to do with that." [REDACTED] said she got off [REDACTED] and walked with [REDACTED] to her house so [REDACTED] could tell her [REDACTED]. Then the two girls went to [REDACTED] house. [REDACTED] said she did not talk to any other students and did not see anyone beat up. This unit asked her if she had any problems with any students at school or knew of any problems with other students in her neighborhood. [REDACTED] said she does not like another student at Sandburg but that was it.

This unit spoke with [REDACTED] and asked if she was involved in a fight or observed a fight on Friday. She said she was not. When asked if she saw anyone that looked beat up she laughed and said she walked straight home alone. She kept saying she didn't do anything. [REDACTED] was also asked if she had any problems with anyone at school and she laughed and said, "everyone in school are snakes (fake) and not worth her time."

This unit called [REDACTED] 9-26-16 around 1400 hours and notified her of the investigation and criminal charges.

This unit called [REDACTED] 9-26-16 around 1445 hours and notified him of the investigation and criminal charges.

On 9-27-16, this unit and School Security talked to several more students from bus [REDACTED] to see if anyone else observed the assault. It was confirmed that on Friday [REDACTED] arrived a few minutes after which is why the two girls were waiting for [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] suspended the students for 10 days with recommendation for expulsion.

Last year [REDACTED] both stole cell phones from the girls locker room and both were charged with Grand Larceny. [REDACTED] ended up being a witness in [REDACTED] court case which went to trial on 9-14-16. A few days before this court case [REDACTED] received threats from [REDACTED] through her friends saying she was going to beat up [REDACTED] was concerned for her safety walking to and from class so the school counselor and administrator permitted [REDACTED] to leave each class 3-4 minutes early to avoid any interactions with [REDACTED] or her friends in the hallways. This unit also suggested that [REDACTED] mom be at the bus stop everyday, morning and afternoon, to ensure [REDACTED] met with [REDACTED] the day after the court case and explained to her that she needed to leave [REDACTED] alone. [REDACTED] told them people are playing with her life and that they needed to know she wasn't going to take it.

Since the two girls have been suspended from school, the girls have threatened [REDACTED] telling them that they are next. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were told that they cannot hangout at the bus stop before or after school. On 9-27-16 around 1445 hours, both [REDACTED] were outside talking to an unknown B/M and the girls pointed at [REDACTED] and said, "I am going to get you." The adult said, "yeah I am going to get my gang on you." [REDACTED] just ignored them and walked away. [REDACTED] later went up to [REDACTED] and asked them, "where is that small girl." The girl they are referring to is [REDACTED]

This unit has some text messages that were exchanged between [REDACTED] court date. In the messages [REDACTED] says she will fight [REDACTED] fights her.

This unit will obtain assault charges for [REDACTED] This unit has sent the report and Intake forms for processing. Nothing further at this time.
