





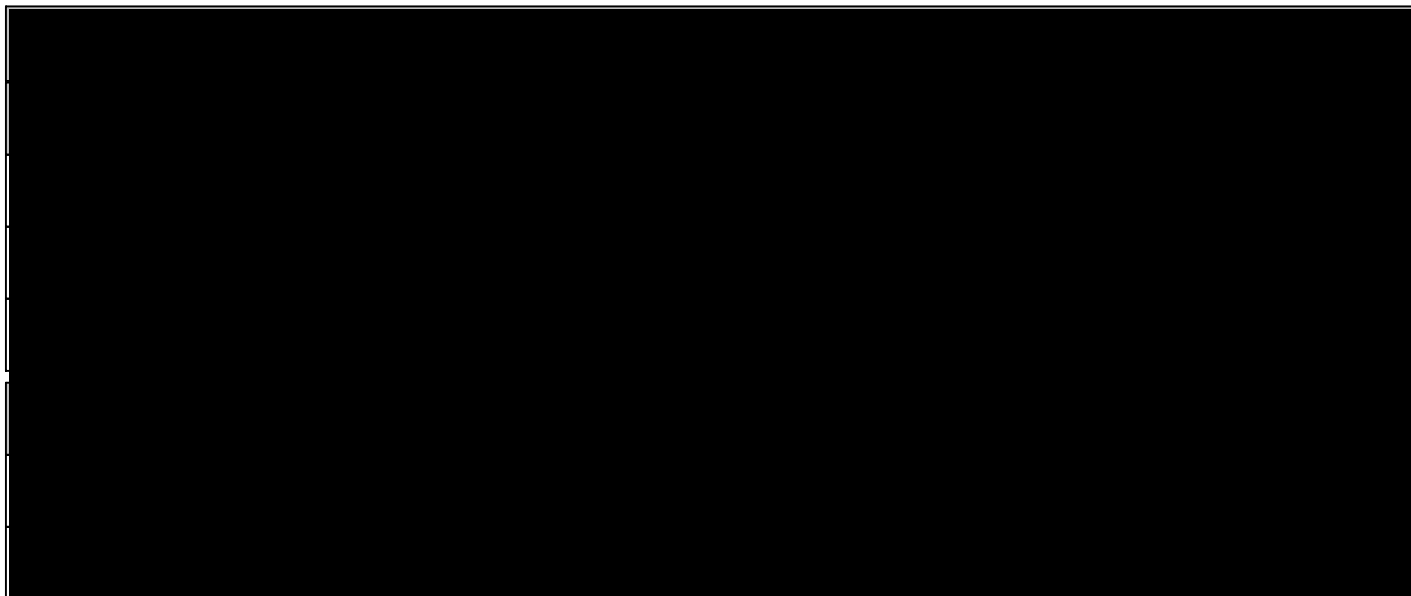

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Notes/Narratives

On 10/12/2016 at 0840 I was dispatched to an EDP at Carl Sandburg middle school. When I arrived on scene I was met by the SRO on scene. She explained to me that [REDACTED] had come to school late and was escorted by staff into the front office to be signed in. When in the office he was unresponsive to the staff or [REDACTED]. He was then lead to the student development office because of his failure to respond. There, after he attempted to leave, faculty told him he needed to sit down. That is when [REDACTED] began to physically fight the faculty and they had to physically restrain him for a few minutes until he was calm again.

A school administrator then called PD for assistance in controlling the student. After speaking to the SRO I spoke with a [REDACTED] at the school. The counselor then advised me that a similar incident occurred the day prior. Yesterday the parents picked [REDACTED] up from school after his physical outburst and took him to [REDACTED] concluded that [REDACTED] was "stable with no imminent risk issues". The family was referred to [REDACTED] at South County intake.

After speaking with the counselor I attempted to speak with [REDACTED]. He was unresponsive, made no eye contact or any acknowledgement when I spoke with him. While I was speaking with the [REDACTED] he was falling asleep in the chair he was sitting in. After he was asked to stand up, he only continued to look at the floor for almost 15 minutes without moving.

After [REDACTED] parents arrived on scene I spoke to them. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] had just [REDACTED] and is having a tough time adjusting to the culture. The parents also advised that he [REDACTED] by his [REDACTED]. The parents stated that [REDACTED] general demeanor is that he is shy and soft spoken. He rarely responds with words to his parents, especially when he thinks he is in trouble. I asked about his interactions with other children and his siblings, parents advised he has no trouble. I also asked about his eating habits at home and they advised he eats fine.

After speaking with the parents I consulted with [REDACTED] and 020B. Both agreed that [REDACTED] should go home with the parents.
