





Notes/Narratives

On 10-26-2016 at 1310 I responded to Carl Sandburg Middle School for two juveniles trespassing on the property. Upon arrival I saw school security, identified as [REDACTED] standing with two juveniles. The two juveniles were identified as [REDACTED]. The school security advised me that the juveniles have been asked to leave multiple times and they refused to leave the property.

[REDACTED] advised me that he asked the juveniles to leave and they refused so he said he would call the police and he did. [REDACTED] advised me that he saw [REDACTED] walking around the school grounds and he asked them to leave. [REDACTED] stated that approximately twenty minutes later he was advised by another teacher the two juveniles were still on the school grounds. [REDACTED] saw the two juveniles walking around and noticed it was the same juveniles he asked to leave earlier. He called [REDACTED] knew [REDACTED] still walked away from [REDACTED] but still did not leave the school grounds. [REDACTED] called for security and they stopped [REDACTED] in front of the school. [REDACTED] were giving school security and the [REDACTED] a hard time when I arrived.

I spoke to both [REDACTED] they gave me extremely bad attitude the whole time. They both were giving me short answers when asking them questions and they were extremely rude. They treated speaking with me as a joke. I asked both [REDACTED] why they were on the property and they stated that they were trying to visit people. I asked why they did not leave when asked and they stated they did not know why they did not leave. I got in touch with both of their parents who agreed to come to the school and pick them up. I sat in the school conference room with them until both of their parents arrived. [REDACTED] informed me that he did not go to school because he missed the bus. [REDACTED] informed me that he goes to Burke. [REDACTED] advised me that he was at school then left because he did not feel good, he informed me that he attends West Potomac High School.

Supplement Notes

I responded to back up [REDACTED] on the Trespassing call as the SRO was in court that day. Upon arrival I saw him trying to speak with the young men but they would only give him sarcastic, vague responses. The [REDACTED] advised when he saw [REDACTED] trespassing he called out to them from their location at the back of the school but they just continued walking. All the [REDACTED] wanted at that point was for them to leave but when [REDACTED] got to the front of the school they decided they wouldn't leave. The security and [REDACTED] asked them to leave but they just danced around mockingly and eventually just sat down on the ground showing that their unwillingness to cooperate or comply at which point the police were called. The boys were then taken into the [REDACTED] office to wait the arrival of their mothers.

[REDACTED] was the most uncooperative and continually swore and made derogatory statements. When his mother came we all spoke with her in the presence of her son. She was advised she also needed to enforce rules and punishments by taking away his multiple phones and video games. She stated that letting him play video games all day is the only way she can keep him in the house at which point she was advised that she was letting him run the house and if he leaves without permission than she needs to report him as a runaway. [REDACTED] chimed in multiple times saying to us in front of his mother that she won't do anything to him that he can do whatever he wants and that he wasn't going to help around the house either because that was for the women. The mother was crying and obviously had lost all control and does not have the fortitude to gain it back. When asked why he didn't just leave the property when asked [REDACTED] who is young and very healthy, just replied because he was tired of walking. [REDACTED] then decided he was not going to listen to the police, parents [REDACTED] or security and advised he's leaving (without his mother). I advised him he was not and he said again that he was. I followed him out of the conference room, through the office and then foyer of the school to the front doors. As this was then going to turn into a [REDACTED] as soon as he reached the doors to exit I put him in an arm bar hold, walked him back into the conference room and sat him down. He then left shortly afterwards with his mother.

[REDACTED] has already been banned from all Fairfax County School Properties. While in the conference room, his mother advised that he has assaulted her in the past. She obviously has no control either and was told that is absolutely unacceptable and to call us from now on every time that happens. This ticked [REDACTED] off and he became irate. He left the office with his mother when they were released and moments later she came back in and said he was refusing to go with her and get in the car. I went out to speak to him and he became irate he could not have his way so he became violent and began yelling and punching the seats. After he stopped I calmly told him that was not acceptable and that tantrum was not going to get him his way. He could either leave with her or us. He chose to go with her. Due to his scary, violent outburst and the mother reporting that he has assaulted her in the past I asked her if she felt ok going home with them and she said yes.

Later I called [REDACTED] to advise her of the violation of his probation to which she informed me there was no consequence or punishment for violation probation
