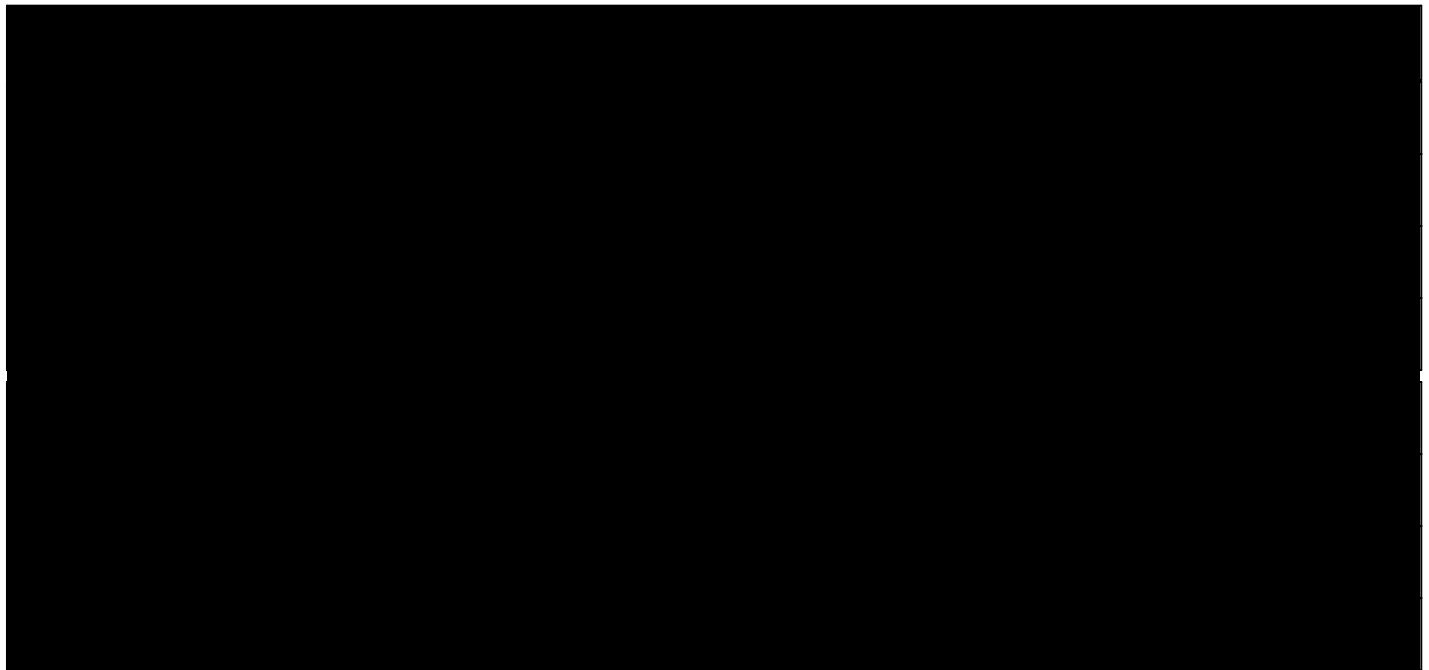

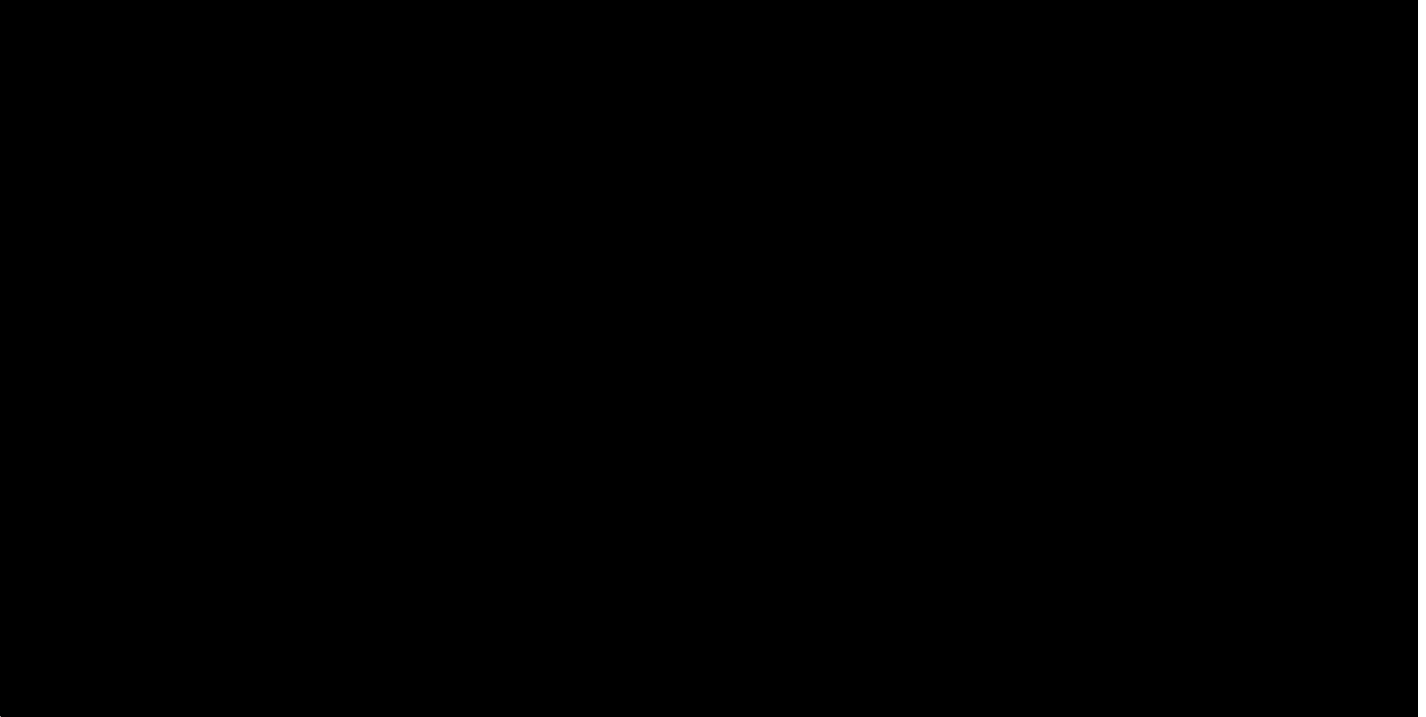

## Notes/Narratives

On Nov 5 2016 I responded to Carl Sanberg for a school alarm. Upon my arrival, [REDACTED] had stopped three vehicles that were attempting to leave the school. While he and K9 were clearing the school, I had all occupants of the vehicles get out and sit on a curb. All individuals were identified as juveniles and they all advised that they had been out at the school playing football. They did advise that when they first arrived at the school about an hr or so prior there were a couple kids on bikes that were climbing on top of the school roof. They could tell me nothing further about them. But they all said that none of them entered the school.

K9 advised that the school was clear and did not appear to be any damage inside. Because I could smell alcohol coming off of two of the four juveniles I contacted all of their parents and each one was picked without incident. All of them were informed that they could not be on school grounds after dark unless it was a sanctioned school event.

## Supplement Notes

I responded to the listed address to assist officers with a school alarm. Motion detectors were received from door 7 to 11. I entered at door 11 and after 2 k9 announcements, I deployed [REDACTED] off lead into the building. He worked to door 7 and then to door 5 where we found one unsecure. The aforementioned areas were the only ones [REDACTED] showed interest in. We cleared the remainder of the school and found a side door to the main office was unsecured. The door latch well on the frame of the door was taped over to prevent the door from securing. It was taped over with clear packing tape. I advised school security of my findings. I saw no areas that appeared to be damaged or in disarray.
