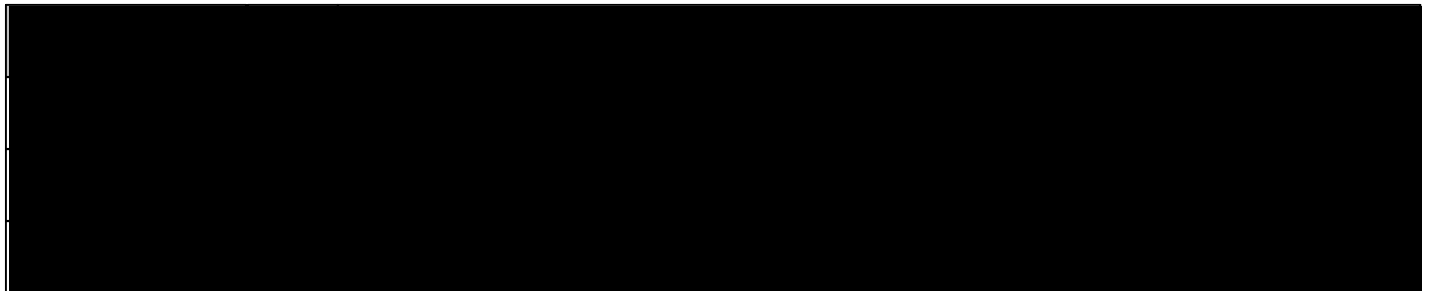
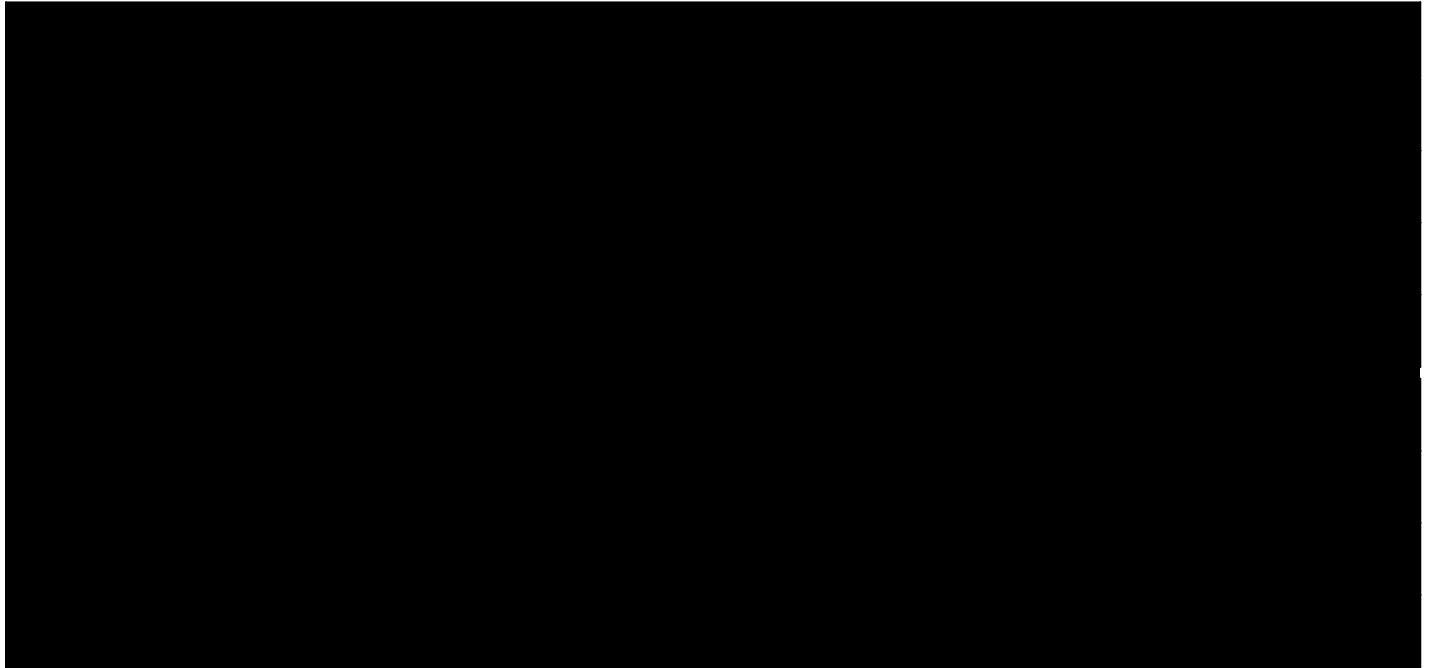

Notes/Narratives

On 12-6-16 I responded to a simple assault/suspicious report at the Carl Sandburg Middle School

██████████ stated that the incident started when ██████████ was told to give her cell phone to the teacher this morning ██████████ was instructed to hand over her phone because she was not allowed to use it at that time in class. ██████████ refused and told the teacher "no" and that he did not pay the phone bill and began to yell profanities. ██████████ was brought over to the In school suspension room to speak with ██████████ to hand over the phone and received a refusal in reply. ██████████ requested for ██████████ to be seated and she refused and continued to yell. ██████████ placed his hands on ██████████ shoulders and requested for her to be seated to have a discussion about her behavior this morning. ██████████ immediately contacted (text) her ██████████ to report the assault.

██████████ dropped off lunch money to the school cafeteria for her daughter around 10:30 am this morning. ██████████ received a text (approximately four minutes after leaving) from her ██████████ that she needed to return back to the school and retrieve her. ██████████ text her ██████████ stating this because the school ██████████ "put his hands on her" ██████████ as a parent felt concerned and immediately called the ██████████ to get an explanation. While briefly speaking to the ██████████ she received a call from ██████████ stating that she needed to return to the school and retrieve her daughter because of an unsafe situation. ██████████ suspension (a detention program) and was not aware of what the ██████████ can do to detain a student.

██████████ witness the interaction between ██████████ which she intervened to stop any further progression. ██████████ intervened by physically getting in between the student and the ██████████ did this to hold back ██████████ from striking the ██████████ did admit to another officer on scene that she wanted to defuse the situation and was upset with the ██████████ on how he handled the incident. No one was physically hurt, hit or injured.

██████████ at in a conference room to discuss what's the conclusion of this event. ██████████ was read the code section 18.2-57 that it's not assault and battery when a staff member uses "incidental, minor or reasonable physical contact or other actions designed to maintain order and control". ██████████ confirmed she understood and agreed it was not an assault but a means of not letting the interaction get out of hand. The ██████████ does not want to suspend ██████████ and would like the ██████████ to seek other means of helping her daughter handle her anger outbursts. ██████████ is taking her daughter home to cool off for the day and will return tomorrow with a fresh start.
