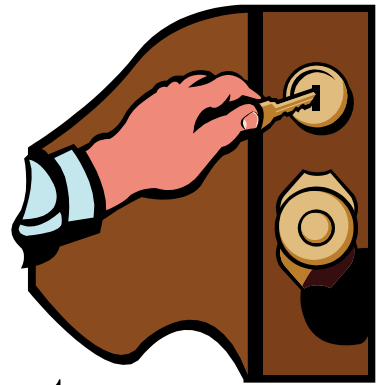


Out of Sight- Lock and Light



A Message from the Fairfax County Police Department

- **Always lock your doors, even when you are home. Lock your car doors, your garage doors and your basement doors**
- **Use the deadbolt lock installed on your door if you have one**
- **If your home is equipped with an alarm system, use it**
- **Turn on your exterior lights at night**
- **Try not to leave purses, cash, keys or valuables near an entryway**
- **Make sure curtains or blinds are closed, especially on the ground floor of your home**
- **Always lock your windows, even on the second floor**
- **Ladders of any kind should be kept away from the house and secured with a lock**
- **Trim bushes and shrubs to keep them away from windows and walkways**
- **Report any suspicious activity in your neighborhood to the Fairfax County Police Non-emergency number 703-691-2131**
