- ❖ Interior decorating should not activate motion detectors.
- * Ensure no movement is present when heating systems are on.
- ❖ Inspect window and door contacts to ensure proper connection once decorating is complete.
- ❖ Winter can produce inclement weather conditions and high winds. Check all doors and windows for any loose fit within the frame.

Holiday Season + Visitors = Temporary Alarm Users

- * All key holders are properly trained to operate your security alarm system, from keypads, to pass codes and how to cancel a police response.
- * Temporary alarm users should be added to your contact list.

 Update information with your alarm company and the False Alarm Reduction Unit.
- Inform your alarm company of your holiday travel schedule, to include individuals housesitting.
