Minutes moved by Mr. Earley, seconded by Del. Watts, approved unanimously with the striking of the erroneous starting time of 7:40.

Subcommittee members edited the draft report developed at the last meeting. Members discussed the 2014 Virginia Inspector General's Report, the Diversion First meeting on August 3, adding a recommendation regarding psych bed availability and the need to have private hospitals at the table in developing diversion program, use of term "mentally ill" vs. "persons with mental illness," the removal of the Sully shooting language, finding appropriate figure for number of inmates with mental illness, inclusion of "training" after "Crisis Intervention Team," inclusion of the statement from Sam Cochran that CIT training without a supportive government is cosmetic, making CIT training a requirement for certain assignments at the Chief's discretion, whether being proactive in dealing with people with mental illness is in fact a duty of police, amount of training for dispatchers, the definition of a Mental

Health Unit and the efficacy of the recommendation, whether training received by dispatchers and deputies is considered CIT under Essential Elements, the legal underpinnings of transfer of custody/emergency custody orders/temporary detention orders, issues with taking a person in mental health crisis to the emergency room, and numerous formatting and clerical edits.
