**Gabrielson Gardens Pedestrian Bridge**

Sealed bids are hereby solicited for construction of a Prefabricated Steel Pedestrian Bridge and Related Work

The work shall include the following:

Construct foundations for bridge, provide and erect a prefabricated steel pedestrian bridge and related work. Contractor to provide structural engineer of record (SER), final bridge plans and foundation engineering plans and building permit.

This is a lump sum Contract. Contract length is 120 calendar days.

**Engineer's Estimate: \$220,000**

Bids are to be submitted to the Director, Fairfax County Park Authority, Planning and Development Division, 12055 Government Center Parkway, Suite 421, Fairfax, Virginia 22035 until **2:00 p.m.** prevailing local time, **Wednesday, May 20, 2020**. A secure drop-off box will be provided outside the front entrance of the Herrity Building. Bids received after that time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at 2:05 p.m. **Wednesday, May 20, 2020 online** by the Fairfax County Park Authority, Planning and Development Division. A video conference link will be sent to all plan holders so they may view the bid opening.

All bidders shall comply with Article A-21, Fairfax County Construction Safety of Resolution, Information for Bidders. Bidder's request for determination of eligibility to bid must be received by the County no later than fourteen (14) days before bids are due in accordance to Article A-18.E of Section A, Information for Bidders. A determination of eligibility may be requested only if a Bidder is subject to conditions in Article A-21.C of Section A, Information for Bidders.

A Pre-Bid Video Conference will be held on **Wednesday, May 6, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. online** by the Fairfax County Park Authority, Planning and Development Division. A video conference link will be sent to all plan holders. All bona fide bidders are requested to participate.

Bidding documents are available electronically in the "pdf" format via ShareFile at no charge by emailing [Thomas.McFarland@fairfaxcounty.gov](mailto:Thomas.McFarland@fairfaxcounty.gov) commencing **Monday, April**

**20, 2020.** Due to the closure of county buildings, this will be the only method to obtain bid documents.

All questions concerning the project shall be submitted in writing to Tom McFarland, Trails Program Manager, Fairfax County Park Authority, Planning and Development Division, 12055 Government Center Parkway, Suite 421, Fairfax, VA 22035 by mail, or via email at [Thomas.McFarland@fairfaxcounty.gov](mailto:Thomas.McFarland@fairfaxcounty.gov) at least seven days prior to the date fixed for the opening of the bids. Tom McFarland can also be contacted at 703-324-8688 between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. This office is the only point where information will be disseminated.

Bid Security must accompany each proposal in accordance with Information for Bidders. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of forty-five (45) days after the opening thereof.

The procedure specified under Section 2.2-4330(A) (i), VA Code Ann. shall apply: "... the bidder shall give notice in writing of his claim of right to withdraw his bid within two (2) business days after the conclusion of the bid opening procedure; ...".

The Fairfax County Park Authority of Fairfax County, Virginia reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities and irregularities in bidding, and to accept bids which are considered to be in the best interest of the Fairfax County Park Authority.
