

2017 — Presently Available data




- 114 Total crashes (82 property damage, 31 injury, one fatal)




- 12 Total crashes (seven property damage, four injury, one fatal)

June 8 – 15, 2022 – Blake Lane at Five Oaks Road SB




- Speed limit: 35 MPH
- Average speed: 36.66 MPH
- Average volume per day: 6,379 vehicles
- Total volume: 38,277 vehicles
- 85th Percentile speed: 41.41 MPH
 (The 85th percentile is the speed at or below which 85% of all vehicles are observed to travel under free-flowing conditions past a monitoring point.)

Blake Lane Speed Study

June 8 – 15, 2022 – Blake Lane at Hibbard Street EB



- Speed limit: 35 MPH
- Average speed: 35.57 MPH
- Average volume per day: 4,150 vehicles
- Total volume: 24,902 vehicles
- 85th Percentile speed: 41.73 MPH
 (The 85th percentile is the speed at or below which 85% of all vehicles are observed to travel under free-flowing conditions past a monitoring point.)



Top 10 Violations – 2021 (County Wide)




Fairfax County Police Crash Comparison

FCPS's Office of Safety and Security (OSS) & Office of Transportation Services (OTS)

- Currently, FCPS has approximately 7500 bus stops, with OTS being the primary FCPS entity to evaluate bus stop/walking safety concerns.
- Throughout Fairfax County, FCPS has bus stop locations on principal and minor arterial designated roads. Moving all stops or limiting all walking routes to a collector or local roadway is unmanageable.
- Per FCPS Regulation 8617 Special Safety Exceptions- OSS can review and make recommendations regarding any needed safety measures ensuring conditions are free of unusual hazards.
- Stops and walking routes are evaluated to mitigate risk, and when a risk cannot be diminished, steps are taken to either add a bus stop or relocate it.
- Over the next few weeks, OSS will work with OTS, VDOT, and FCPD to review the bus stop locations along Blake Lane, confirming they are age-appropriate and all possible safety measures are implemented.
