Girls on the Run (GOTR), founded in 1996, is a nonprofit organization designed to enhance participants' social, emotional, and physical skills. What began as a program with only 13 participants has since grown astronomically and now serves over two million participants from coast to coast. Students in grades third through eighth are welcome to participate. GOTR has a long-standing and unwavering commitment to building a world where any and every girl can know and activate her own limitless potential through developing skills that will help her successfully navigate life's experiences.

Each year, GOTR hosts hundreds of 5Ks across North America, making it one of the largest 5K series in the world. This year, for the first time, the GOTR 5K will take place at two different locations in Fairfax County, at Fair Oaks Mall, and at BASIS Independent School in Tysons.

Each event requires over 100 volunteers to be successful. GOTR is currently looking for dedicated volunteers to make this Spring 2023 5K a success! # **Packet Pick Up**

Help distribute bibs and t-shirts during the week prior to the 5K.

#### Cheer Marshal

Cheer for participants as they pass by along the course during the 5K.

## **Parking**

Direct participants and spectators where to park.

#### **Water Station**

Distribute water to participants at a designated water stop along the course.

#### **Road Runner**

Complete the 5K with a program participant while providing support and encouragement.

#### **Lead Medical Tent**

Manage medical activity as needed with EMS on standby for emergencies.

#### **Corral Marshal**

Lead each wave from the holding area to the start line.

#### **Bike Marshal**

Leads the 5K on bike to ensure participants follow the route.

# Runner's Village

Assist with activity stations before the 5K begins.

## **Registration Tent**

Help Buddy Runners register, answer general 5K questions and distribute shirts and bibs

#### Start/Finish Line

Distribute medals, snacks and water as participants cross the finish line.

#### **Bus Greeter**

Direct participants exiting buses where to go upon arrival; direct buses to bus parking and alert GOTR NOVA staff of teams who have arrived
