






Initial Concerns and Suggestions

- 1. Speeding, accidents, and drag racing (FCPD & FCDOT) a. Traffic Study from FCPD
- 2. Road diet and traffic calming (FCDOT & VDOT)
- 3. Guard rails, lighted signs, reflectors, and chevron signs (VDOT)
- 4. Visibility (VDOT)
- 5. Timing change for traffic lights (desynchonization and long waits at rush hour) (VDOT)



Residential Traffic Administration Program (RTAP) \$200 Fine for Speeding Signs

Measures:

"\$200 Additional Fine for Speeding" signs added underneath speed limit signs.

Qualification:

- The road must be a local road, a collector road, or a minor arterial with a speed limit of 35 MPH or less.
- The road must have at least 600 vehicles per day.
- The 85th percentile speed of vehicles is at 10 MPH over the speed limit.
