#### **FOIA Fees Assessed**



#### **FOIA Fee Waivers**

12,243

Per County policy, waivers should be considered when the total cost of the FOIA request is less than \$50.



#### **INTERESTING DATA**

- On average, Fairfax County received **67 requests** per working day.
- The Office of Public Affairs managed **1,114** FOIA requests.
- **\$1,262.00** was the highest paid FOIA fee.
- Fairfax County agencies processed 7% more FOIA requests in FY 23 than in FY 22.
- 89% of FOIA responses were sent via e-mail, and 11% were distributed in-person, over the phone, via fax or by letter.
- More FOIA requests were received in March (1,770) than in any other month.
- The Office of Public Affairs conducted **25** FOIA trainings to **over 500 attendees**.
