## Dear Resident:

The above-referenced Fairfax County project is occurring in your neighborhood (see map on the back). This letter is to inform you that in the following weeks, engineers and survey crews acting on behalf of Fairfax County intend to perform utility location near your property to assist in the design process for improving the sanitary sewer serving your neighborhood. The project involves improving some of the force main and gravity sewer at Newton Street and Vale Rd. Field crews will perform utility location activities which might cause noise for a limited time frame during the day. We will remain within Fairfax County's existing sewer easements and VDOT right-of-way where available to prevent disturbance to property owners.

This letter is provided to inform you that work crews will be in your area beginning the week of February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and will continue surveying over the next few months to collect data required for the engineering and design of the proposed project. Activities will include marking and locating surface and subsurface features on and around your property so that the design can be completed with minimum disruption. The County of Fairfax, Virginia Water Design and Construction Division (WDCD) is in the early design phase for improvements to the gravity sewer downstream of the Lakevale Estates Pump Station and does not yet have construction plans, as the survey data is needed for us to create a design.
