Substantial Completion: Summer 2026

Benefits: Enhanced Community Services (childcare and workforce education opportunities) and new energy efficient heating & cooling systems (geothermal wells)

Project Status:

- Week of 12/23/24:
 - · Stormwater utility installation ongoing
 - Continue Geo-thermal horizontal loop installation.
 - · Steel window restoration at East façade of main building.
 - · Continue miscellaneous demolition work inside the main building.
 - HVAC layout & duct installation.
 - Structural steel work on the 2nd floor of the main building.
 - Interior wall layout throughout the 2nd floor of the main building.
- Weeks of 12/30/24, thru 1/20/24:
 - Continue Geo-tnermal horizontal loop installation.
 - Steel window restoration at South facade building C.
 - Stormwater utility installation ongoing
 - Continue selective demolition inside the main building.
 - · Continue MEP under-slab work inside the main building.
 - Installation of the stormwater chamber adjacent to Maury Place.

Community Advisory:

- The jobsite will be closed on New Year's day, January 1, 2025.
- Trucks will be entering jobsite on Maury Place only. The Mohawk Lane entrance has been closed due to well drilling.

 Note: SmootDC, the general contractor, is on site and will continue to manage traffic control and safety during all activities as required.
