Dear Resident:

The above-referenced Fairfax County project is occurring in your neighborhood. This letter is to inform you that in the following weeks, the Contractor acting on behalf of Fairfax County intends to repair defective work that occurred during the construction of the gravity sewer along Langley Lane to improve the sanitary sewer system serving your neighborhood. The Contractor will mobilize on or after April 3, 2023.

This project phase consists of spot repairs of sags in the newly installed gravity sewer pipe that runs under the street. Traffic detours will be implemented to route non-local traffic around this segment of Langley Lane while the spot repairs take place:

Field crews will perform construction activities which might cause noise for a limited time frame during the day. We will remain within Fairfax County's existing sewer easements and VDOT right-of-way as well as adhere to the Fairfax County Noise Ordinance to prevent disturbance to property owners.

The crew will work with residents to ensure driveway access throughout the project. It is recommended that you give the crew a 20-minute head's up if they are working in front of your driveway, so that they can place a steel plate over the excavation or move their equipment. Most houses have double driveways and the crew will do their best to only block one driveway at a time.
