In 2025, negotiations for continuing HGA design services are scheduled to begin, and associated shelter design activities are expected to restart in May 2025 upon resolution of project site and land development concerns.

RRMM submitted a final round of site plan review responses and received site plan approval by Town of Vienna on 12/16/2024. The building plan review approval is expected by late January 2025. RRMM submitted the bid documents to BDB for review on 12/9/2024. The Building Design and Construction Division is currently preparing bid advertisement documents for review followed by advertisement for bid in late 1/2025.
