This award will be presented to individuals, schools, youth and adult organizations, civic organizations and other organizations that have volunteered their time and effort to preserve, protect or plant trees. Nominations will be accepted for ongoing projects or projects completed in the calendar year before the year of nomination. Examples of projects that can be nominated include: tree preservation actions, education programs, tree planting projects, and innovative maintenance programs. An "Outstanding Individual Friends of Trees Award" may be awarded to any individual(s) who displays superior tree preservation and/or planting attitudes and actions.
