Licensed Collectors to Resume Selected Collection Services Required by Chapter 109.1

Effective Monday, June 15, 2020, two of the mandatory waste collection requirements for refuse and recycling collectors that were suspended during the COVID-19 pandemic will be reinstated. The specific requirements that will resume being in effect are as follows:

- 1) Source-separated yard waste collection must be provided on at least a weekly basis to all residential customers (per Section 109.1-5-3 (d) (3)); and
- 2) At least 30 days' written notice must be given to the County and to all affected customers prior to altering collection service (per Section 109.1-5-7 et al).

This change effectively rescinds the relief of these two requirements described in SWA 20-002 and SWA 20-003. In the event of any conflict between this document (SWA 20-006) and earlier Advisories, this document shall prevail.
