FY 2022 SOLID WASTE COMMERCIAL DISPOSAL RATES SCHEDULE

The tipping fee for solid waste at the I-95 Landfill Complex, I-95 Energy/Resource Recovery Facility and I-66 Transfer Station Complex will be **\$66** per ton during Fiscal Year 2022 (July 2021-June 2022).

◆ Fairfax County Solid Waste Tipping Fee	\$66.00 per ton
◆ Brush, all customers	\$47.00 per ton
◆ Yard Waste (bagged & unbagged), all customers	\$64.00 per ton
◆ Vacuumed Leaves	\$44.00 per ton
◆ Minimum Charge (all materials – not C&D) - Small	\$25.00 per load
◆ Minimum Charge (C&D) - Small	\$30.00 per load
◆ Minimum Charge (all materials) - Medium	\$35.00 per load
◆ Minimum Charge (all materials) - Large	\$70.00 per load

All fees are subject to change depending upon conditions/regulations. Failure to comply with the County Code or facility rules and regulations may result in a penalty fee of \$100.00 per ton.

Please note that disposal companies may use other permitted brush and yard waste processing facilities to handle your brush and yard waste. However, if other sites are used, monthly invoices cannot be processed through your Fairfax County account.

Tire disposal rates are as follows:

◆ Passenger	\$185.00 per ton
◆ Truck	\$250.00 per ton
◆ Rubber Tracks/Solid Tires/Oversized	\$350.00 per ton
◆ Tires on rims are charged an additional fee	\$9.00 per rim
◆ Additional charge for dirty, muddy tires	\$25.00 per ton
◆ Minimum Charge (tires)	\$90.00 per load
