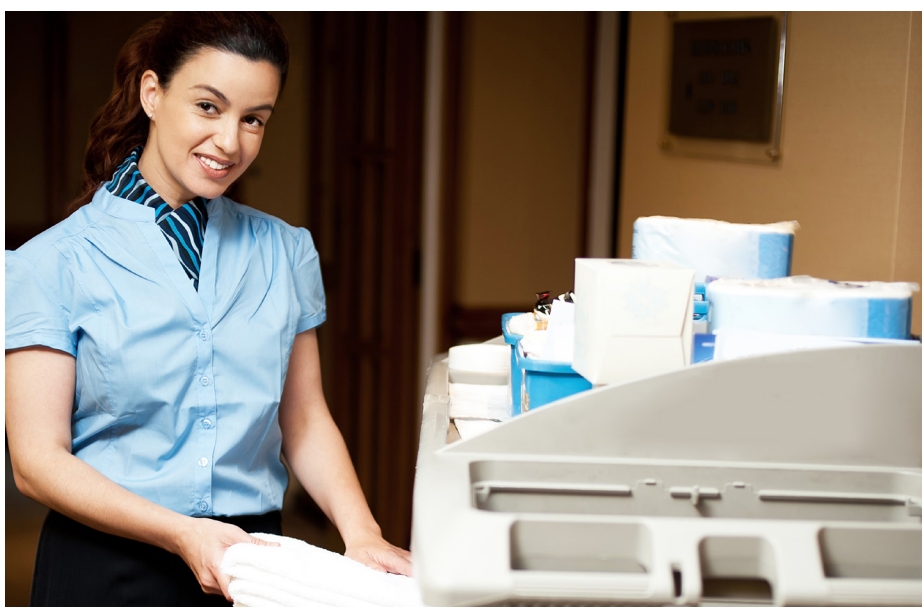




# Waste Reduction Tips

- Use dishes, ceramic mugs, and glassware for your guests.
- Use paper products made from recyclable or compostable materials. Some examples include napkins, paper towels, toilet paper, bags, etc.
- Choose suppliers that can provide reusable or recyclable packaging.
- Don't use Styrofoam® when possible. It takes up more room in both storage and disposal than paper/cardboard products. Almost everything available in Styrofoam® is available in a paper equivalent.
- Use environmentally friendly cleaners. Cleaners that can be used for multiple surfaces are better than job-specific cleaners.
- If space permits, buy in bulk to reduce packaging waste.
