**TESTING FOR BLOOD BORNE PATHOGENS ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, Section 32.1-45.2 of the Code of Virginia provides authority for the General District Court to issue an order to require that blood be drawn and tested from an individual who may have exposed a member of a public safety agency to blood borne pathogens.

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff of Fairfax County, Stacey A. Kincaid, has submitted information to this Court that \_\_\_\_\_, who was at the time confined in the Jail of Fairfax County, may have exposed Deputy Sheriff \_\_\_\_\_ to blood borne pathogens.

**FURTHERMORE**, that the Director of Health Services of the Fairfax County Health Department has stated that they believe that exposure to blood borne pathogens may have occurred as stipulated in Section 32.1-45.2 of the Code of Virginia.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Sheriff of Fairfax County transport \_\_\_\_\_ to a medical facility so that blood may be drawn and tested for blood borne pathogens, or...

**IT IS ORDERED** that the Fairfax County Sheriff's Office Medical Personnel draw blood from \_\_\_\_\_ and that said blood be tested for hepatitis B & C, and Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and the results of said tests be reported as stipulated in Section 32.1-45.2 of the Code of Virginia.
