MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM PENALTIES FOR CONVICTION OF VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE OF INMATE OFFENSES

MAJOR OFFENSES - CLASS I - HEARING OFFICER

- 1. Verbal or written reprimand and notation in inmate's classification/AIB file.
- 2. Loss of privileges to one of the following for up to 15 days:
 - Recreation
 - Commissary
 - Programs
 - Television
 - Visiting (except with attorney)
 - Telephone Use (except to attorneys)
 - Furloughs and Community Passes (AIB only)
- 3. Disciplinary Segregation for a period of from 1 to 15 calendar days for each offense.
- 4. Loss of any portion or all good conduct time accumulated for each offense conviction or change in DOC custody level.
- 5. Recreation, Personal Visitation, and Programs are automatically suspended during the entire disciplinary segregation period.
- 6. In addition to the above sanctions AIB inmates may be revoked or suspended from an AIB Program or transferred to another AIB program, in combination with, or separate from any other sanction.
- 7. Imposition of a behavior contract (AIB only)
- 8. Payment of restitution

*NOTE:

- The maximum amount of disciplinary segregation time an inmate may be penalized is not more than 60 days for all violations arising out of one incident. The Sheriff or his/her designee must approve, in writing, any sentences greater than 30 consecutive days in disciplinary segregation.
- 2) Anytime an inmate accumulates more than 30 days of continuous disciplinary segregation, the Supervisor, Classification Section or designee shall notify, in writing, the Commander, Confinement Division through the Chief, Classification and Records Branch.
