Rabies Clinic

This Sunday, November 6th, the Animal Shelter will be offering a low-cost rabies clinic! It's open to residents of any county, and will be held at the Sully District Government Center at 4900 Stonecroft Blvd, Chantilly VA, from 12 noon to 2pm on November 6 and December 4. Dogs, cats, and ferrets can be vaccinated at the clinic. Please ensure that dogs are on

leashes, and cats and ferrets are in carriers. If you have a previous rabies certificate, please bring it! Each vaccination is just \$15 (cash and check only), and you can also purchase a 2017 Fairfax County dog license for an additional \$10.

Dulles Suburban Center Study

The public is invited to the next two upcoming Dulles Suburban Center Study Advisory Group meetings. The next meeting will be held on **November 7, 2016, 7:00 PM** at the Sully District Government Center in the large community room (4900 Stonecroft Blvd. Chantilly, VA 20151). At this meeting, the submission DSC-J-1 (Commonwealth Centre) will be discussed with the Advisory Group.

General Location: North of Westfields Boulevard, East of Newbrook Drive loop road Proposed Change: Add option for multi-family, single-family attached residential development and retail and theatre uses up to .50 FAR.

The following meeting will be held on **November 15, 2016, 7:00 PM** at the Sully District Government Center in the large community room (4900 Stonecroft Blvd. Chantilly, VA 20151). At this meeting, the submissions <u>DSC-D1-1</u> (<u>Middleton Farms</u>) and <u>DSC-D1-2</u> (<u>Jackson Property</u>) will be discussed with the Advisory Group.

General Location: South of Frying Pan Road, East of Route 28 Proposed Change: Add an option for single-family attached residential units at a density of 5 dwelling units per acre (du/ac).

General Location: Southeast of the Frying Pan Road and Sunrise Valley Drive intersection Proposed Change: Add an option for residential development at 10-12 dwelling units per acre.


