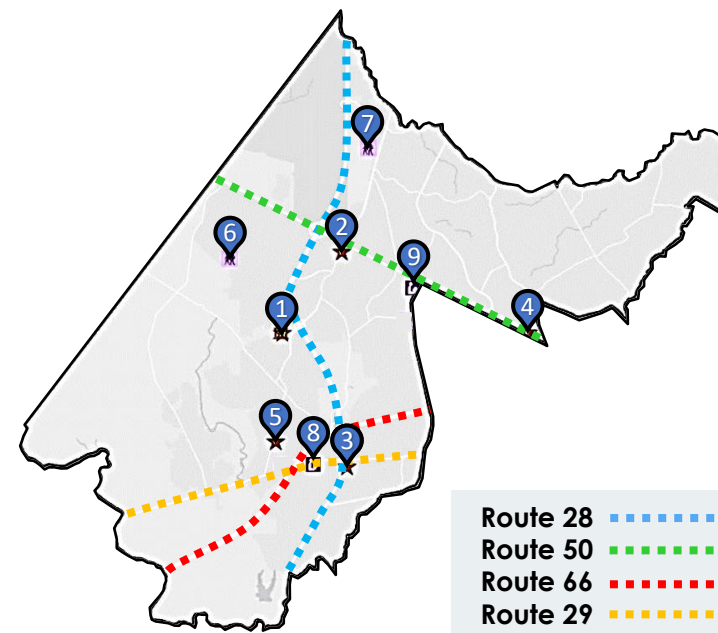

The Fairfax County Board of Supervisors have allocated \$7 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to establish the **THRIVE program**. Eligible small business entities will be able to apply this coming fall to receive targeted consulting services valued up to \$10,000 per applicant. The program will look to help approximately 600 grant recipients meet their business goals and continue their post-pandemic recovery.

**PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Business located in Fairfax County
- Have 49 or fewer employees
- Be able to demonstrate COVID-19 negative economic impact
- Established prior to December 31, 2021
- Businesses of all types may apply (including home-based businesses/sole proprietors)
