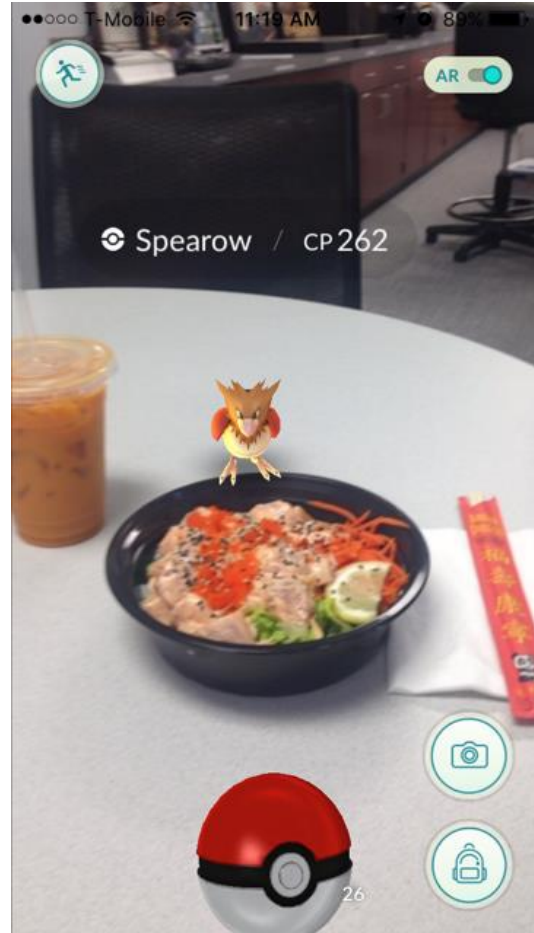
We also had some great news this week on transportation issues. In 2013, then Gov. McDonnell created some new funding sources for transportation and the money would be allocated through the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA). The 2017 budget was passed this week with \$466 million in spending across the entire region- and \$305 million of that investment is coming here to the Sully District! This funding for improvements to the I-66/VA-28 interchange will be a major part of the I-66 transformation that VDOT is working on. Combined with the Governor's recent announcement of a \$50 million dollar investment at Dulles Airport our area is seeing a record year for infrastructure improvements! You can see the details on the NVTA investment below.
