OAA IDIC/Gold Standard funds used for Fairfax's FY24 local match. Previously awarded OAA Cooperative Partnership funds not needed in FY26 so not eligible to be carried forward per OAA. It is expected that OAA will award Cooperative Partnership funds for this project in future years. In FY 24-25, spent ~\$33,500 on building design/engineering. Planning to apply to OAA for FY27 cooperative partnership funds (~\$1M).
