Presentation of "Brief History of Lake Accotink and Description of the Accotink Watershed" from Adam Wynn, Senior Planner with the Fairfax County Park Authority, John Burke, Natural Resource Branch Manager with the Fairfax County Park Authority, and Charles Smith, Branch Chief, Fairfax County Department of Public Works and Environmental Services.

Discussion and comments. Ideas mentioned include:

- Long-term impacts of any decision regarding Lake Accotink should be assessed, including social and community issues and costs.
- The watershed should be looked at holistically with respect to condition, issues, needs, potential solutions, and sustainability.
- Subcommittees could be created to address specific topics.
- Field trips to local stream restoration projects/managed wetlands/Lake Accotink.
