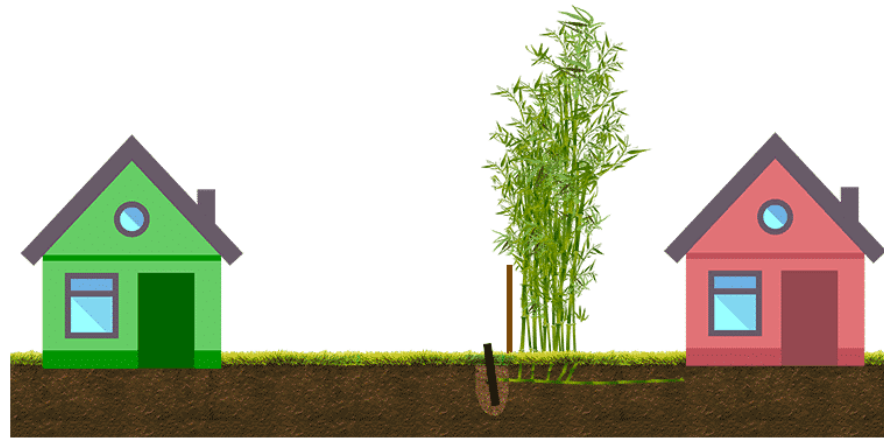


Avoid The Fine!

What you should know about Running Bamboo in Fairfax County

- Starting January 1, 2023, running bamboo must be contained on the owner's property.
- Running bamboo is an invasive plant with a complex root system that can spread aggressively underground.
- Running bamboo can push through brickwork, drains, cavity walls, patios and exploit cracks or weaknesses in concrete.
- The county's Department of Code Compliance will enforce the new ordinance.
