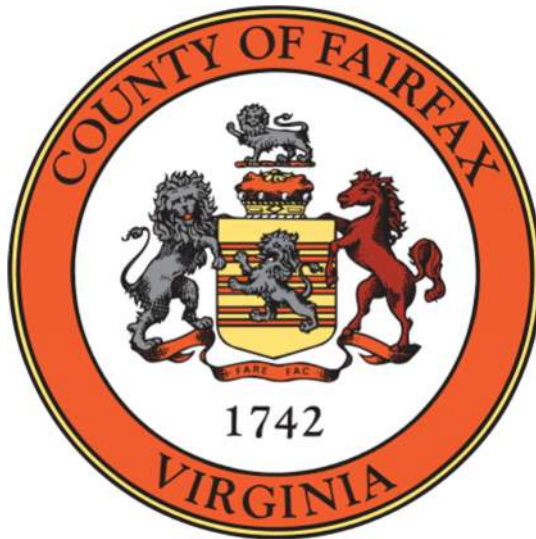

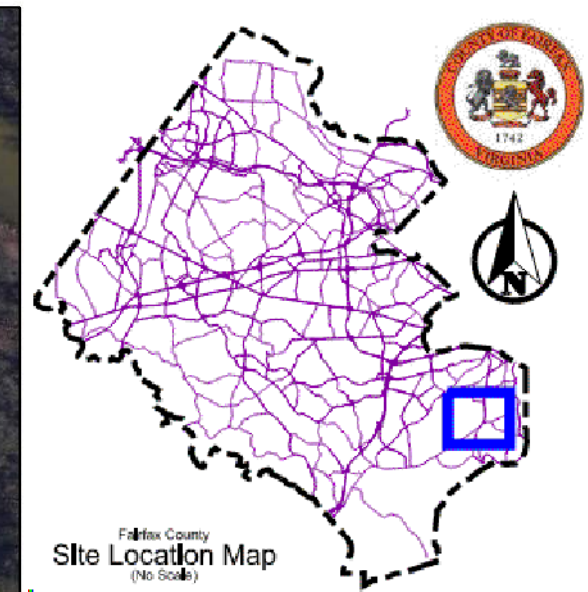



Project Scope/Assumptions

- Assumed all improvements to Route 1 will precede the construction of this project.
- Alignments are shown as provided by Fairfax County and are not to be considered the final shared use path location
- Proposed shared use path will have a pavement structure as follows:
  - 2" SM-9.5D
  - 4" Aggregate Base Material 21-B
- Assumed no large drainage structures within areas of this project
