

Project Scope/Assumptions

- South King Highway improvements include full depth pavement, sidewalk, shared use path, curb and gutter.
- Assumed all improvements to Route 1 will precede the construction of this project.
- Alignments are shown as provided by Fairfax County and are not to be considered the final roadway location
- All Proposed pavement will be full depth and have a pavement structure as follow:
 - o 2" SM-9.5A
 - o 2" IM-19.0A
 - o 8" BM-25.0A
 - o 8" Aggregate Base Material 21-B
- Roadway lighting provided along the entire length of project.
- New signal at S Kings Hwy/Memorial Street.
- Assumed no demolition costs/total takes included in this estimate due to redevelopment
