- 2021 TAC Activities
 - Work Plan development and establishment of culture
 - Resolutions regarding Route 1 corridor and ActiveFairfax; letter regarding Safe Routes to Schools
 - Continuation of historic role in oversight and engagement; site visits; TAC Awards
- Key Meetings
 - FCDOT-hosted February 27, 2021 all-day Planning “Off-site”
 - Met with Deputy County Executive November 17, 2020 and November 16, 2021
 - January 18, 2022 meeting with BOS Transportation aides

Important Elements of 2022 Work Plan

- Guiding Principles
 - Holistic; Recognize complexity and multiple different perspectives; Integrate with economic development, land use, equity and environmental concerns; Question pre-COVID assumptions; Solicit citizen involvement; Fairfax as a test bed
 - Goal of TAC: *Not just take a position, but point to a solution*
- Focus Areas
 - Transit oriented development; Vehicle congestion mitigation; Trails, sidewalks and bikeways; Strategies and policies; various Areas to monitor
 - Each focus area has lead Commissioner(s) assigned, as noted in plan
 - Focus areas are tied to Fairfax County Comprehensive Plan, as noted in plan
- Outreach Partners
 - TAC plans to work collaboratively with County stakeholders
 - Most important TAC partner: FCDOT
