There will be a study regarding bike. There is a grant request for Little River Turnpike bike improvements. BTWD was very successful. Bike Coordinator position - still doing interviews.

The committee is of the opinion that there should be better standards for repaying of pot holes and patches on roads. Members were aware of several repaying projects that were of a poor quality.
