Purpose and Need

Project Background:

- Previous studies identified this corridor for pedestrian and bike enhancements
- The community input indicated that crosswalk visibility and new pedestrian connections were priorities
- This project provides a new pedestrian and bike facility on the west side of Westmoreland Street along with other pedestrian enhancements along the corridor from Kirby Road to Lemon Road



Project Overview

Existing Conditions:

- Nearby schools and recreation facilities
- Long crossing distance for pedestrians
- No pedestrian facilities on west side of street
- Limited shoulder and drainage ditch width

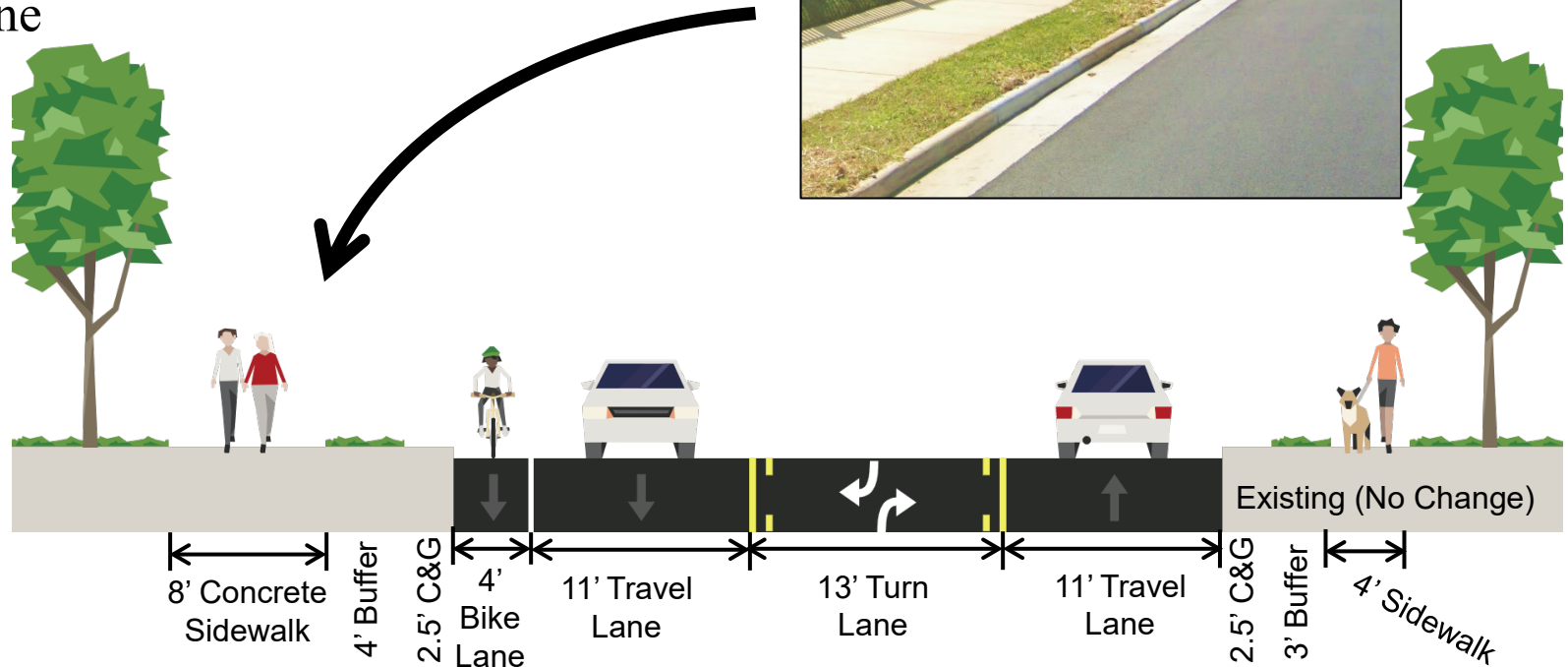




Project Overview South of Poole Lane

Proposed Design Elements:

- 8' concrete sidewalk, 4' buffer with curb and gutter and southbound bike lane



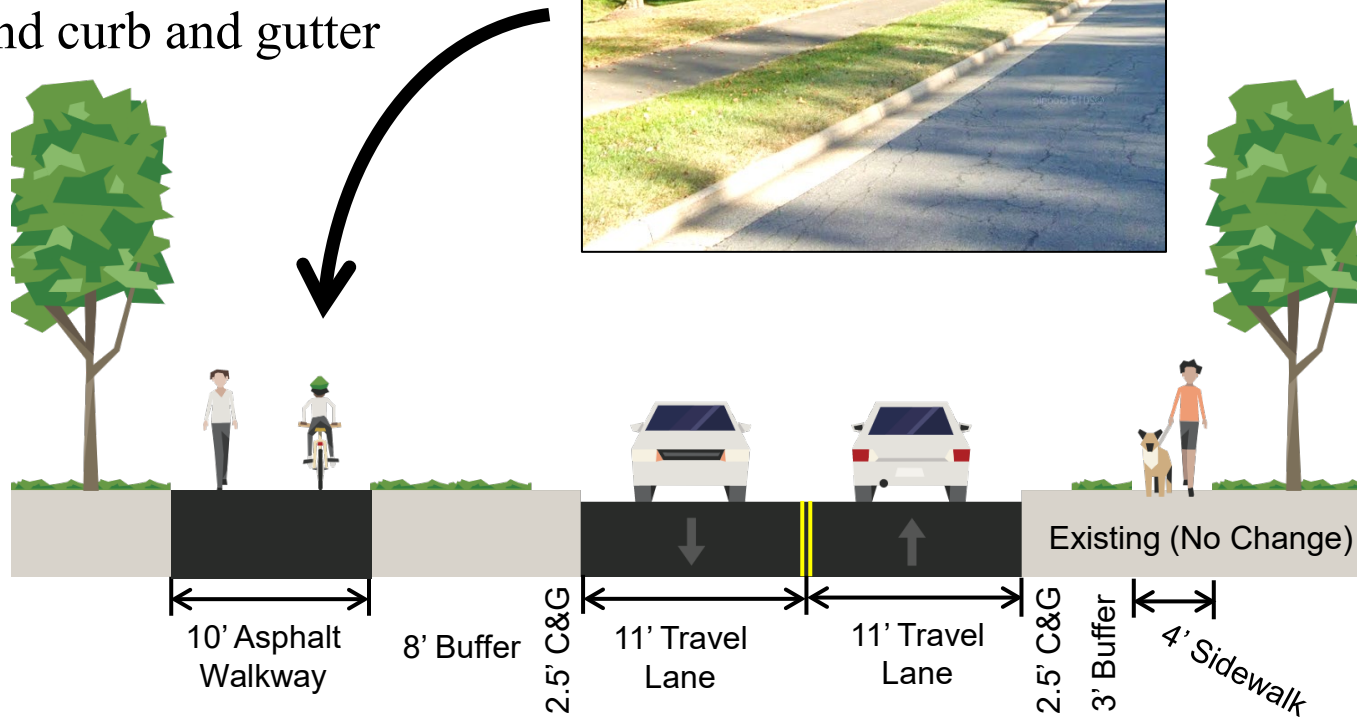


Project Overview

Proposed Design Elements:

- 10' asphalt walkway with 8' buffer and curb and gutter



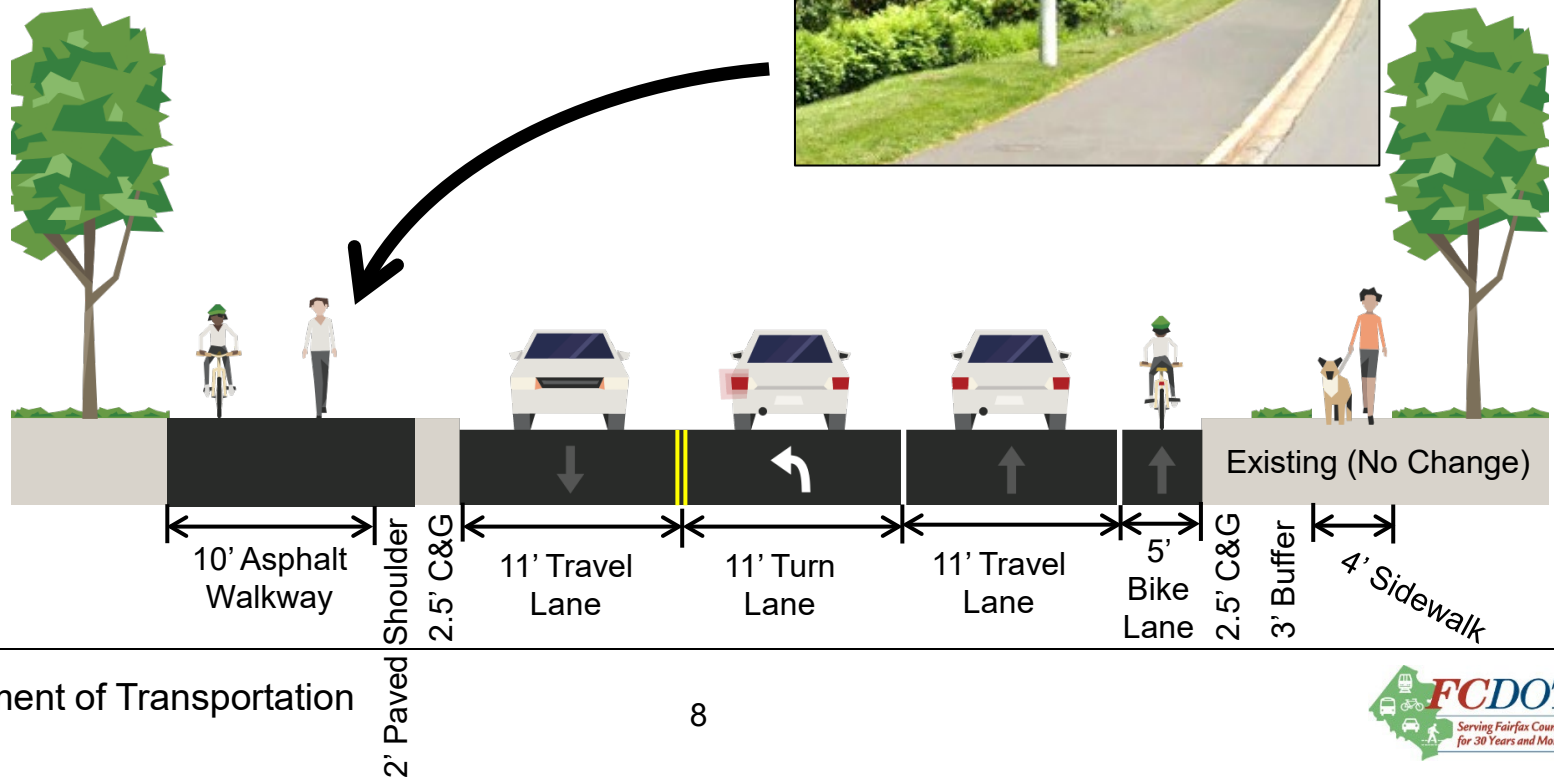


Project Overview

Between Somerville Drive & Lemon Road

Proposed Design Elements:

- 10' asphalt walkway and 2' paved shoulder with curb and gutter

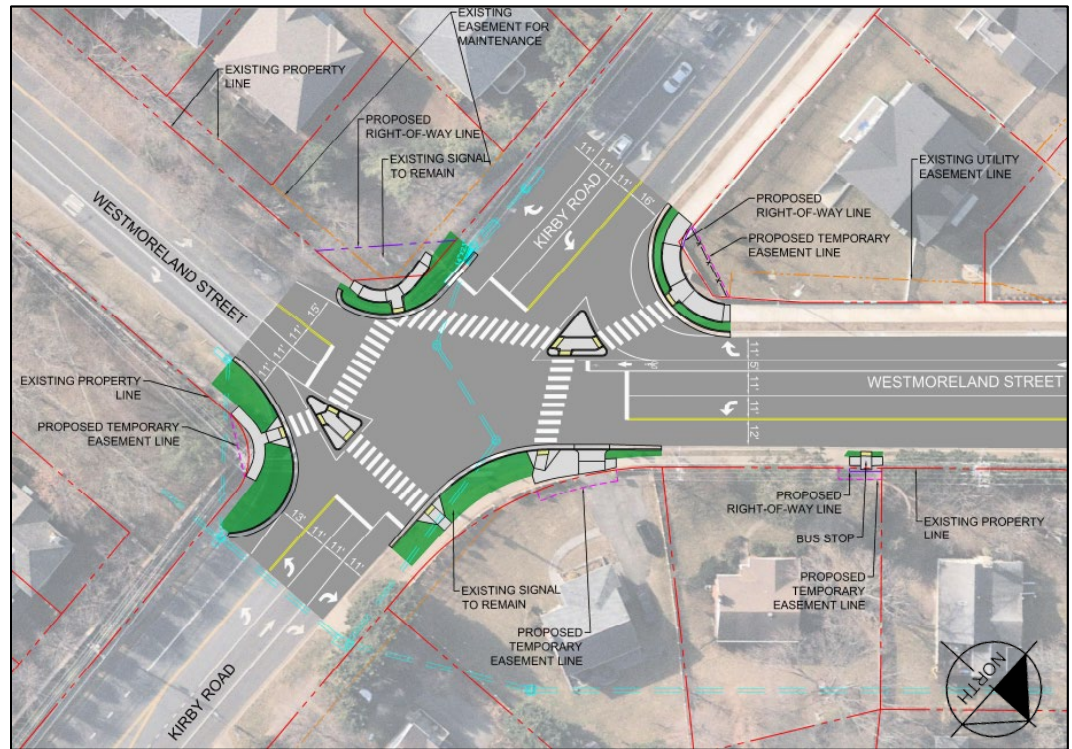

- Curb extensions





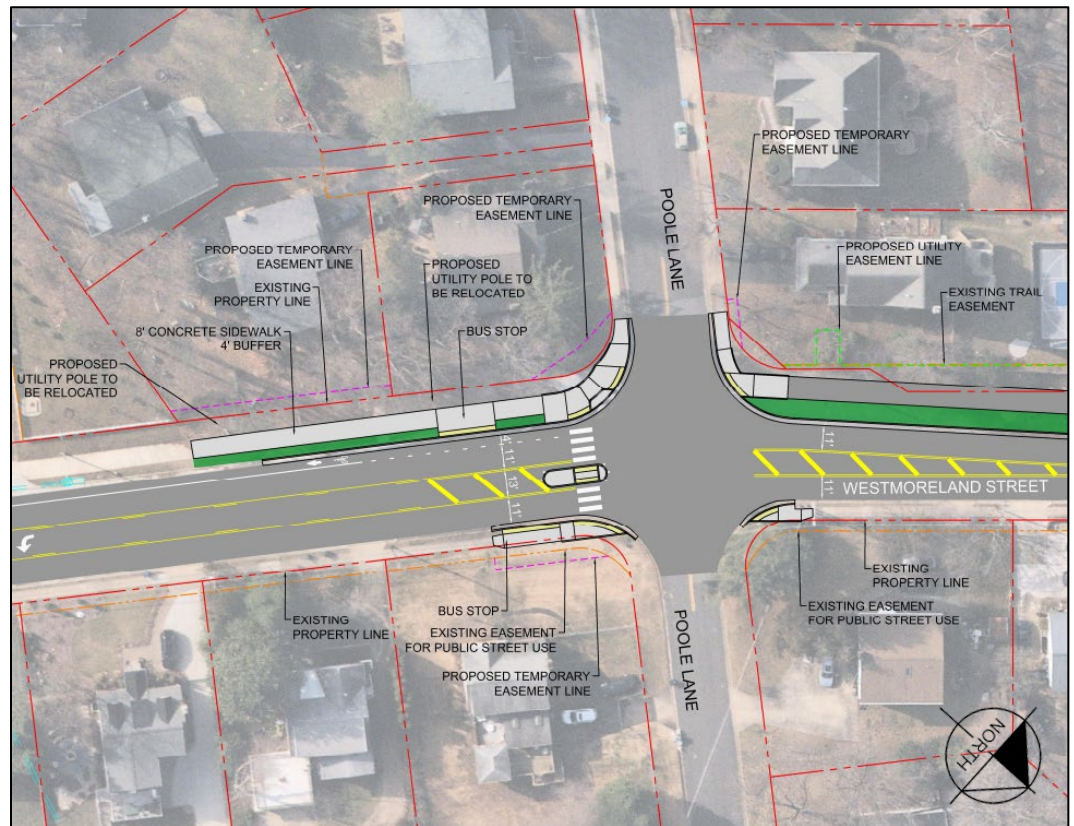

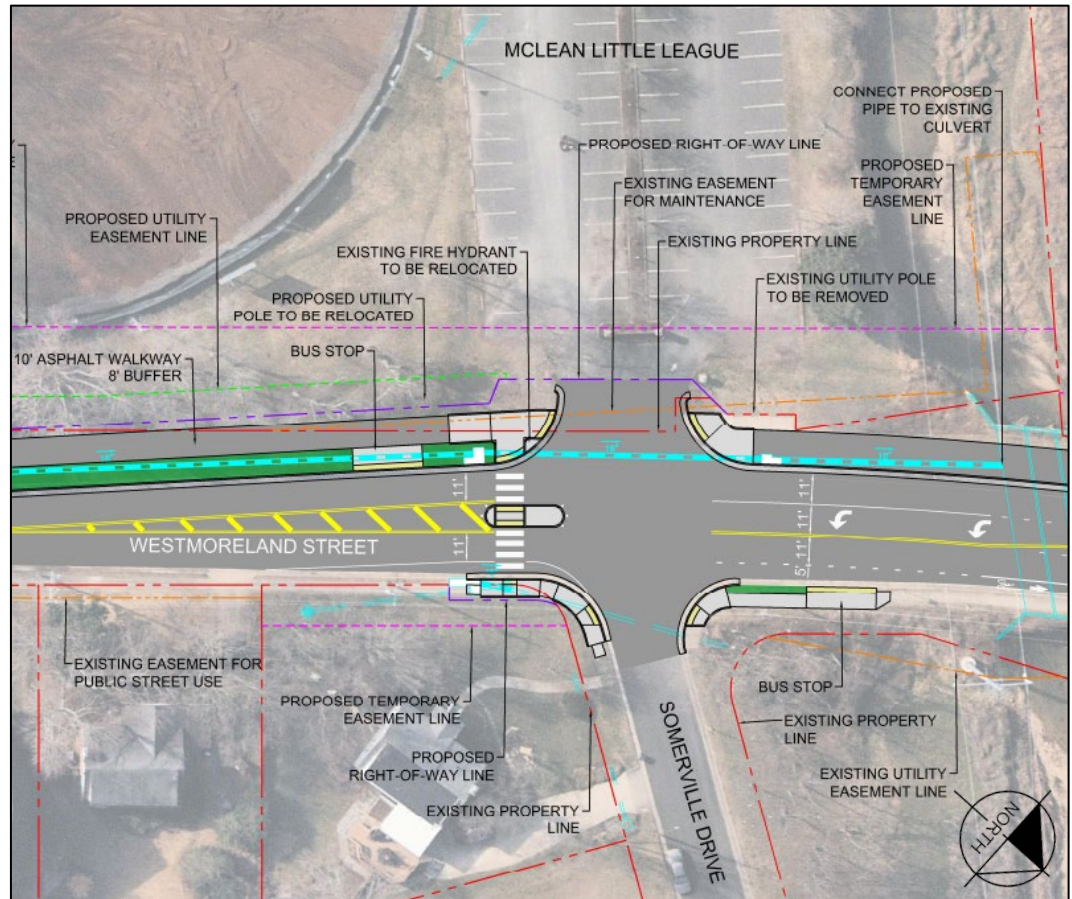

- Enhanced bus stops

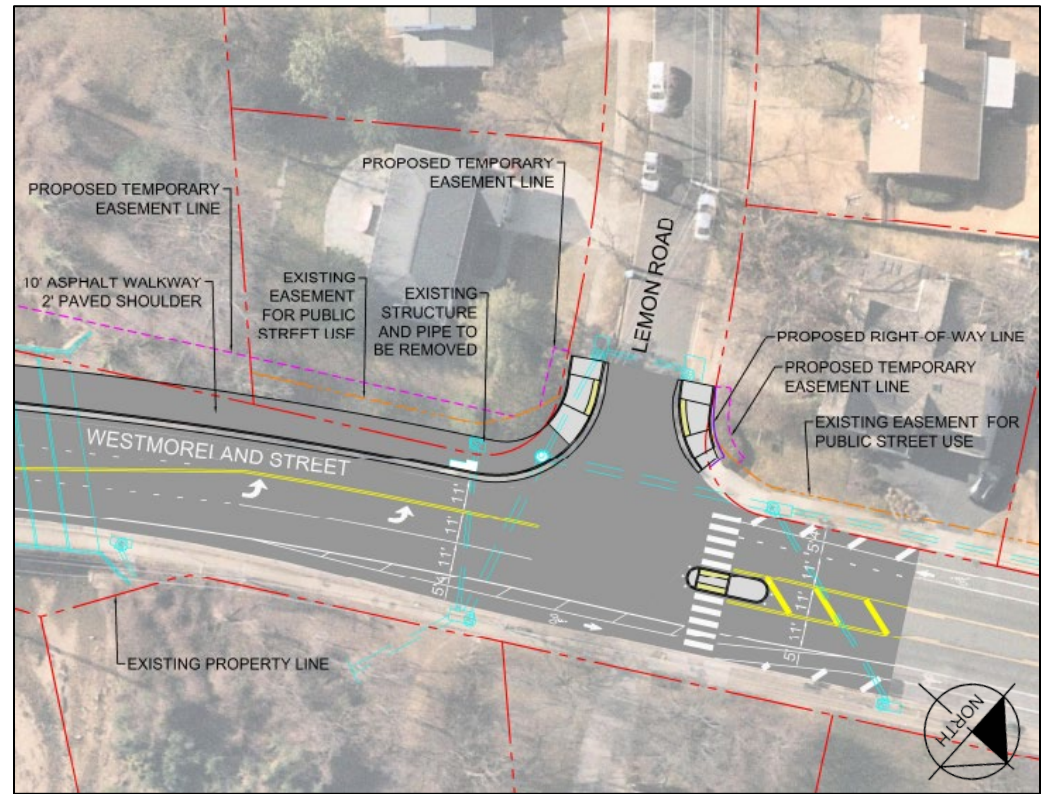

- Upgraded curb ramps (ADA compliant)

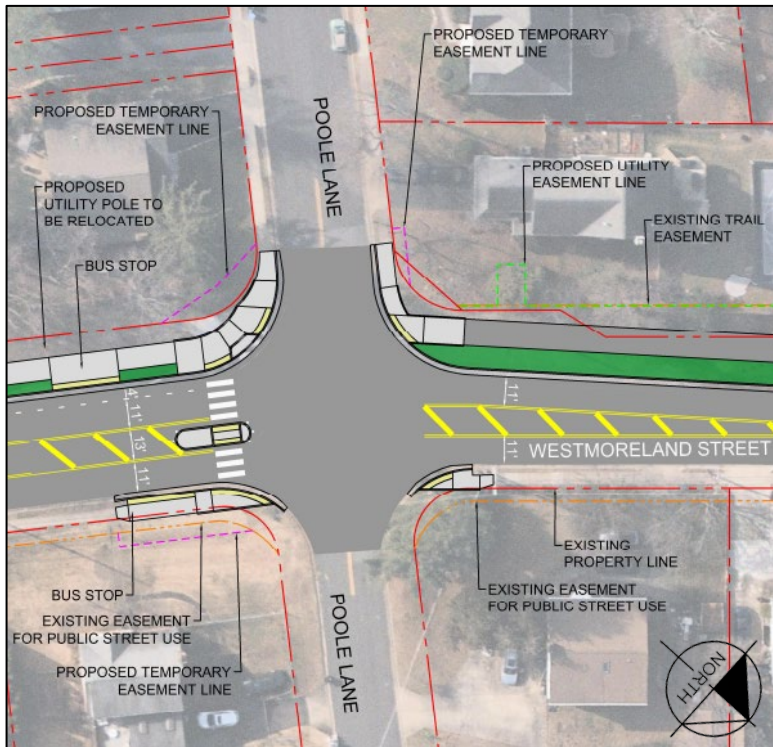

- Pedestrian Median Islands

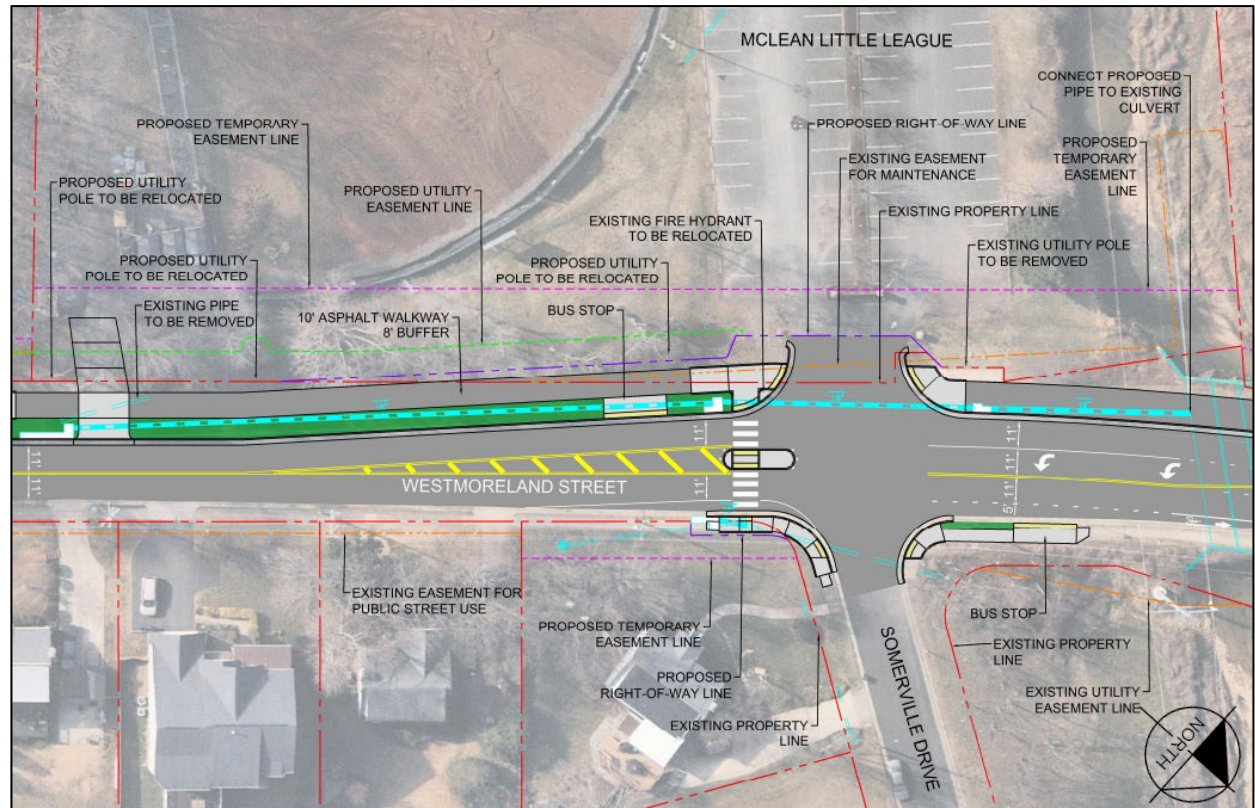

- New inlets and pipes to replace the existing roadside ditch

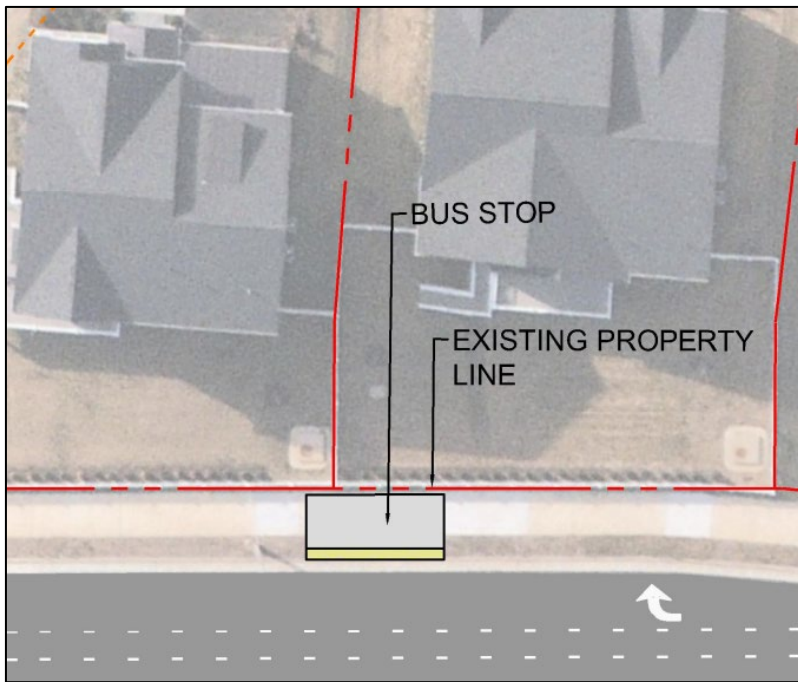




Project Overview

- Limited vegetation removal for sight distance and grading

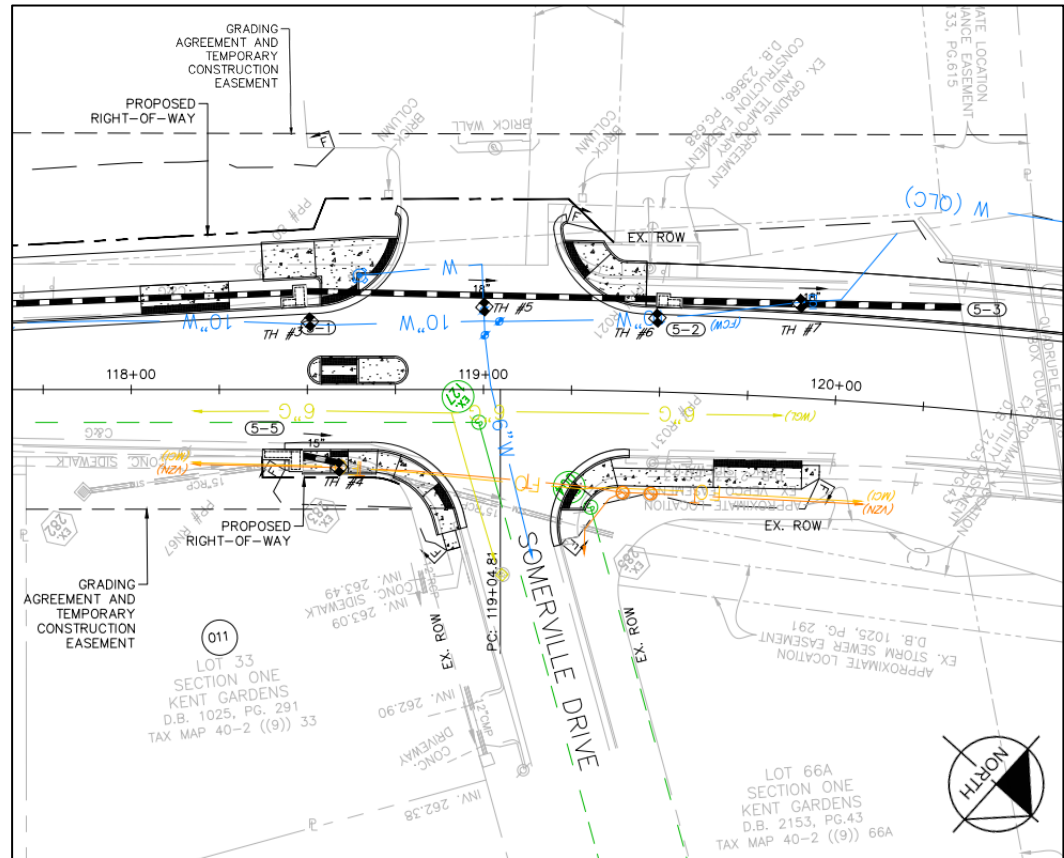

DESIGN ELEMENT	RIGHT-OF-WAY DEDICATION (# of Parcels)	PERMANENT UTILITY EASEMENT (# of Parcels)	TEMPORARY GRADING EASEMENT (# of Parcels)
10' Asphalt Walkway	6	3	15

Based upon Pre-Final plans there are 16 impacted parcels within the project limits.



Schedule Summary

- **Final Design:** **June 2023**
- **Start Land Acquisition:** **July 2023**
- **Complete Land Acquisition:** **March 2024**
- **Complete Final Design** **April 2024**
- **Utility Relocation Start:** **May 2024**
- **Utility Relocation Complete:** **October 2024**
- **Construction Start:** **Winter 2024**
- **Construction Finish:** **Summer 2025**
