Dulles Rail Phase 1 and 2
Transportation Improvement District Advisory Boards
March 12, 2020

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Phase 1

- Old Meadow Road Realignment 100% design complete
 - ➤ Utility relocation almost complete
 - ➤ Roadway construction to resume in Feb 2020 and is scheduled to be completed in June 2020
- VDOT Punch List
 - Sidewalk, underdrains, ADA ramps, VDOT structures repairs ongoing
 - > DCR median stormwater repairs in the spring
 - ➤ All items expected to be completed by fall 2020
- Phase 1 Close out \$2.982B (no change)

General Activities

- > Safe braking and dynamic testing
- > Property conveyances and maintenance agreements
- > Site inspections and walkdowns
- > Software system integration
 - Wiehle-Reston East Station weekend shutdowns completed in the fall and to resume in spring/summer 2020 to accomplish Phase 1 and 2 tie-in

Construction Status

- > Civil stormwater management ponds and punch list work
- Stations Interior finishes, station clean up, and elevator and escalator testing
- ➤ Track Clean-up along the guideway from the Reston Town Center Station to the Ashburn Station
- Systems All Traction Power Substations (TPSS) energized, train movement from Wiehle to beyond Ashburn
- Rail Yard Punchlist work for all building at the yard and installation of hoist equipment ongoing
- MWAA and WMATA identified concerns Discussions on remediation are ongoing
 - Concrete Panel and Concrete Ties/Cross-Level Deficiencies
 - ➤ Fouled Ballast, Insulated Joints, Switches, Surge Arresters, & Fuel Center at Dulles Rail Yard
 - Systems Integration and Automatic Train Control
 - > Spare Parts

- Package A (Rail, systems, stations) completion Mid 2020 (target)
- Package B (Yard) completion Fall 2020 (target)
- WMATA Board to establish Revenue Operations Date


Fairfax County Parking Garages

Herndon Station Garage

- Total Project Estimate: \$44.5M (org. \$56.7M)
- Construction Progress:
 - New Garage opened to the public on April 8, 2019.
 - Existing garage repair work completed September 30, 2019. Reopening expected before Silver Line Phase 2 revenue services.
 - Bus loop was repaved and reopened to the public on January 5, 2020.

Innovation Center Station Garage

- Total Project Estimate: \$52M (org. \$57M)
- Construction Progress:
 - Garage is 97% complete.
 - Substantial completion date: March 2020.
 - Installing elevators and finishes inside the garage.
 Finalizing utility installation and testing. Completing the bioretention pond.

Recommended preferred plan

- New connections and routes
 - Chantilly/Centreville to Dulles Corridor
 - NVCC (Loudoun Campus)
 - Sterling to Herndon
- Creates more direct connections
- Shortens travel time
- Increases access to transit dependent population and employment
- Maintains significant bus stop coverage
