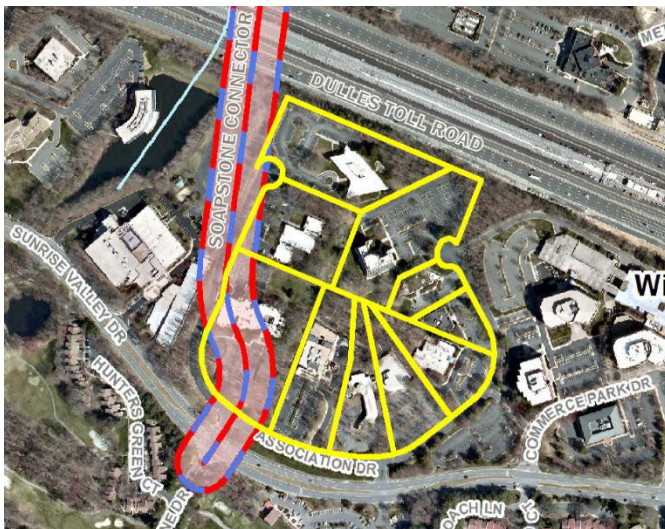


Public Information Meeting Soapstone Connector Project Supplemental Phase I Architectural Survey

The Fairfax County Department of Transportation will hold the next public information meeting on the Soapstone Connector project to present information and gather feedback on the Architectural Survey completed on the southern area of the project, including 10 parcels on Association Drive south of the Dulles Toll Road. The survey was conducted at the request of the Virginia Department of Historic Resources to record the buildings in the office park and to make a preliminary recommendation regarding the eligibility for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

The Soapstone Connector Project would provide a direct connection between Sunset Hills Road and Sunrise Valley Drive as recommended by the Reston Metrorail Access Group (RMAG).
