

Silver Line - One Year Later

From WMATA:

- Silver Line Phase II served over 3.5 million trips (entries and exits)
 - Between Jan '23- Dec '23, ridership grew 50% faster at Silver Line Phase II stations than the rest of the system
- In FY24, Silver Line Phase II has consistently served:
 - Average weekday: 13,000 trips (entries and exits)
 - Average Saturday: 10,000 trips (entries and exits)
 - Average Sunday: 9,000 trips (entries and exits)
 - 24% of trips take place on weekends, compared to 19% in the rest of the system
- Dulles and Ashburn are still the most popular stations:
 - A third of all Silver Line Phase II trips start or end at Dulles
 - Nearly 8x more rides than the 5A Metrobus pre-pandemic (Nov '18 – Nov '19)
- Popular destinations for Silver Line Phase II customers continue to be stations served by the Silver Line in DC (35%), the Silver Line in Virginia (35%), and long-distance transportation hubs (8%)
