

County of Fairfax Residential Cut-Through Permit Program Permit and Temporary Pass Application

To apply for a RCTP permit, you must be a resident of a permit-eligible address within a Permit Zone, and the legally registered owner or lessee of the vehicle. The vehicle must be properly registered with the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) at the permit-eligible address unless an exception (listed on Page 2) applies.

Payment: Fee of \$24 per permit is required with this form. Payment must be made my check, payable to <u>County of Fairfax</u>, and mailed or delivered in person to the Fairfax County Department of Transportation, 4050 Legato Road, Suite 400, Fairfax, VA 22033. To apply and pay online, visit https://www.tocite.net/fairfaxcounty/portal/permit.

Exception Conditions: All categories require additional document to be submitted before a permit can be issued. FCDOT staff will follow-up by email for required document if not provided.

Active Duty Military:

Additional documentation is required:

- Copy of resident's current driver's license (out of state)
- Copy of current vehicle registration (out of state) to include VIN and plate number
- Verification of active duty and/or relocation (military orders)
- Copy of resident lease (only pages showing tenant names, move-in date and lease duration, landlord information, and contract signature (required) or mortgage/closing document (showing date address acquired) to confirm address

Full-Time Student:

Additional documentation is required:

- Copy of resident's current driver's license (out of state)
- Copy of current vehicle registration (out of state) to include VIN and plate number
- Verification of full-time enrollment during the **CURRENT** semester (document must show applicant's name, name of college or university, semester, and number of credit hours enrolled)
- Copy of resident's CURRENT lease (only pages showing occupant names and lease duration),
- Landlord contact information (email and phone)
- Any additional required documentation (e.g., Driver's Other's Vehicle form, etc.)

New Resident Moved from Outside of Virginia:

Additional documentation is required:

- New Resident Temporary Permits are valid for 60 days and provided free of charge
- Copy of current driver's license (out of state)
- Copy of current vehicle registration (out of state) to include VIN and plate number
- Copy of resident's **CURRENT** lease (only pages showing occupant names and lease duration)
- Copy of lease (only pages showing tenant names, move-in date and lease duration, landlord information [email and phone], and contract signatures required) or mortgage/closing document (showing date address acquired) to confirm RCTP address

Resident with New Vehicle/ New Plate:

If resident has an existing permit and online account, they can update license plate information online.

If there is no online account, resident must provide paper application and new vehicle registration.

- Fee is waived as no new permit is required for new license plates.
- If new vehicle, applicant must provide vehicle registration or temporary registration if vehicle has temporary plates.
- Permit fee is waived for vehicles with temporary plates and existing permit holders who have sold/traded permitted vehicle prior to October 31 of any calendar year.

Resident Driving Company/ Government Vehicle:

Additional documentation is required:

- Resident Driving Company or Government Vehicle Form
- Copy of the vehicle registration to include VIN and plate (if out of state)

Diplomat:

Additional documentation is required:

- Copy of driver's license issued by the U.S. Department of State
- Copy of current vehicle registration issued by the U.S. Department of State
- Copy of lease (only pages showing tenant names, move-in date and lease duration, landlord
 information, and contract signatures required) or mortgage/closing document (showing date
 address was acquired) to confirm address if different than address on driver's license and/or
 vehicle registration.
