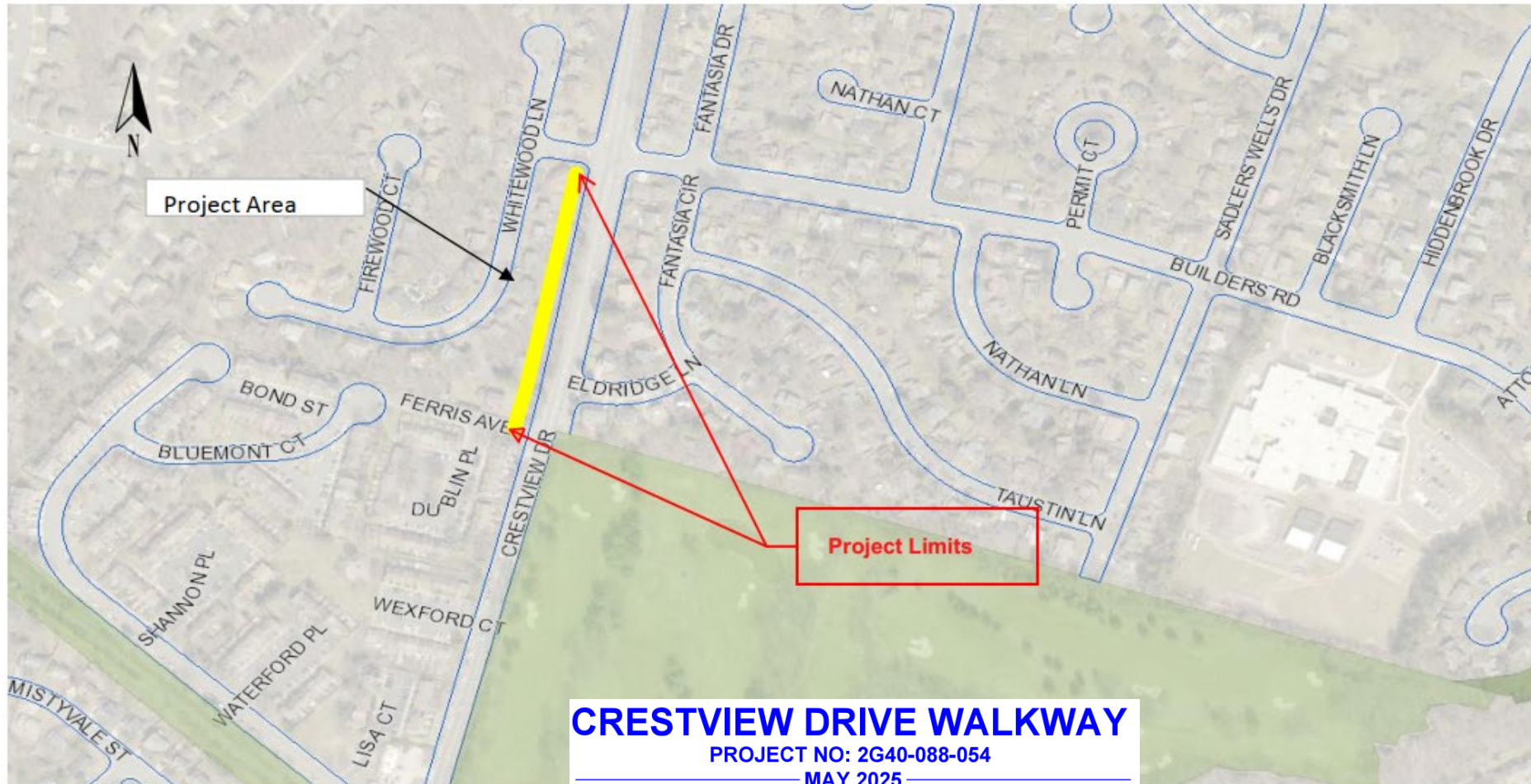

Crestview Drive Facing North Approaching Eldridge Lane on the Right

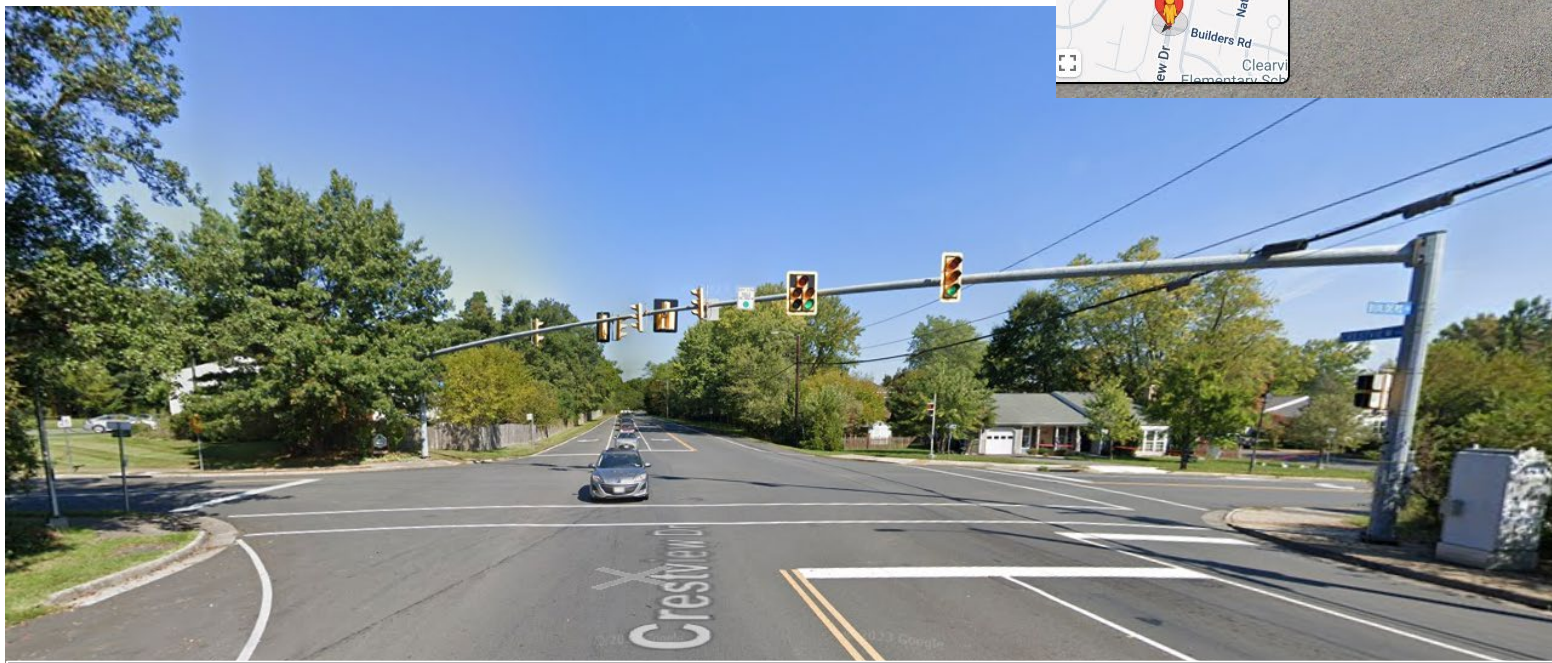


Crestview Drive Facing South Approaching Ferris Avenue on the Right

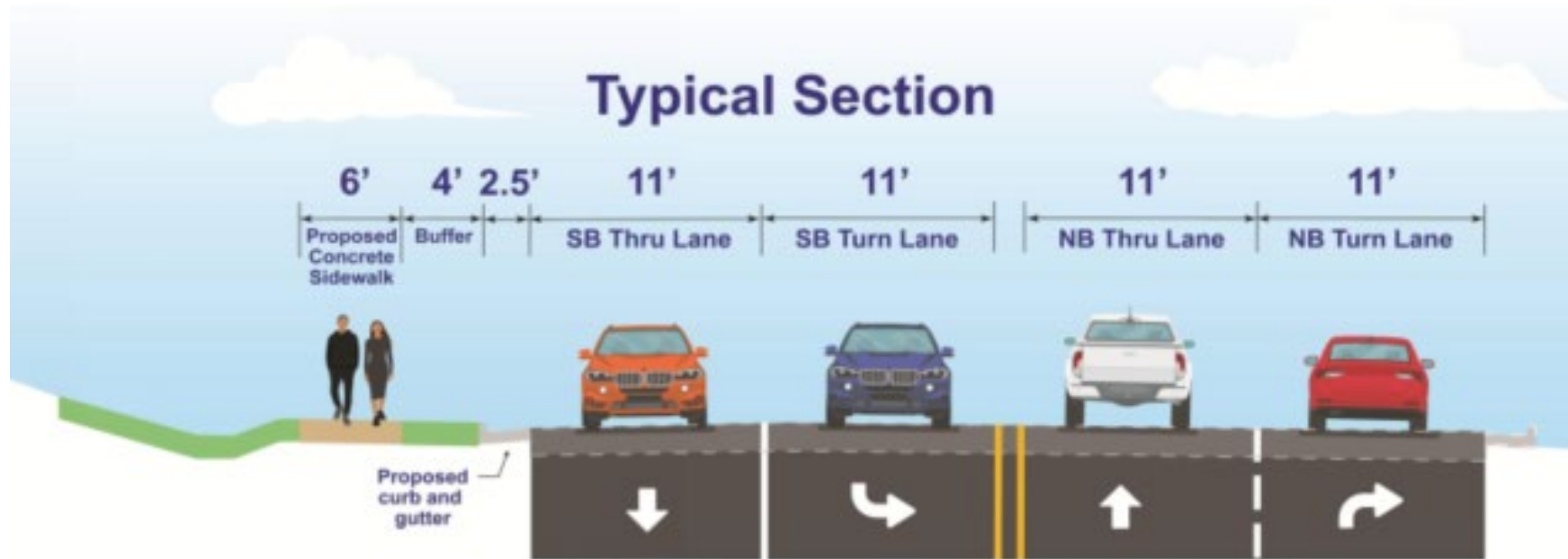

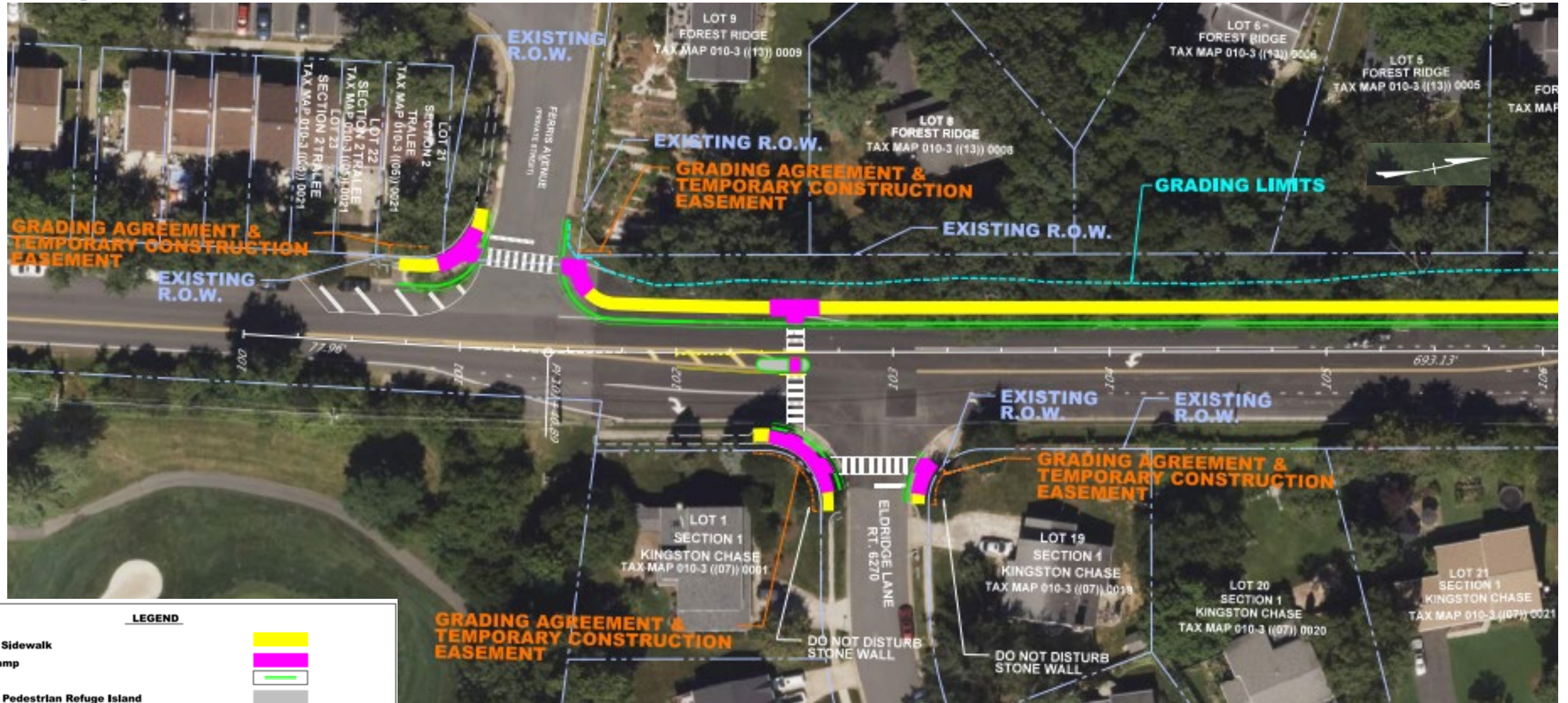
West side of Crestview Drive between Ferris Avenue and Builders Road

## Proposed Improvements

- Construction of a 6' wide, approximately 850' long concrete sidewalk
- Installation of new crosswalks and pedestrian signals
- Construction of a new 8' wide refuge island
- Installation of ADA curb ramps



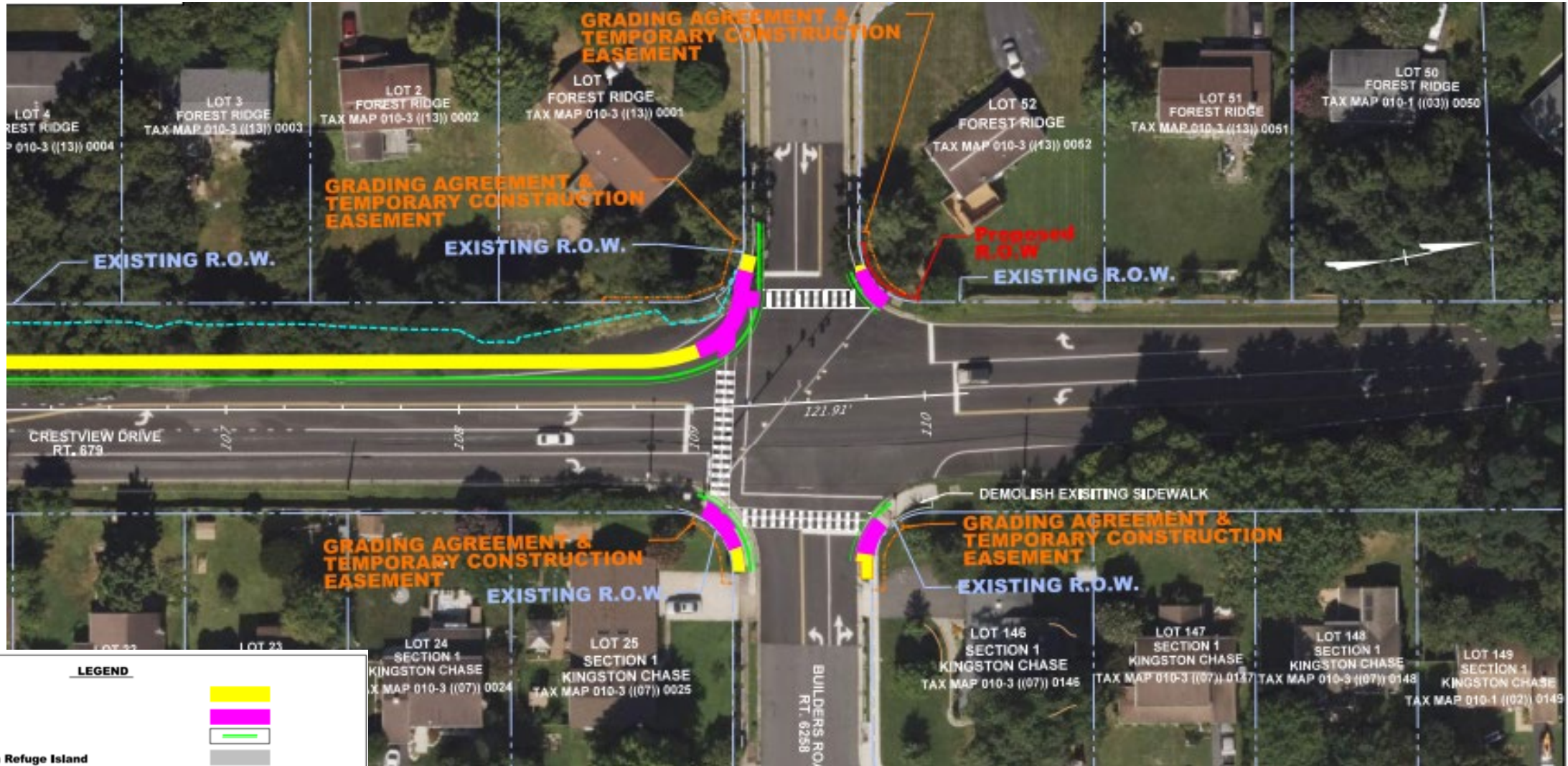

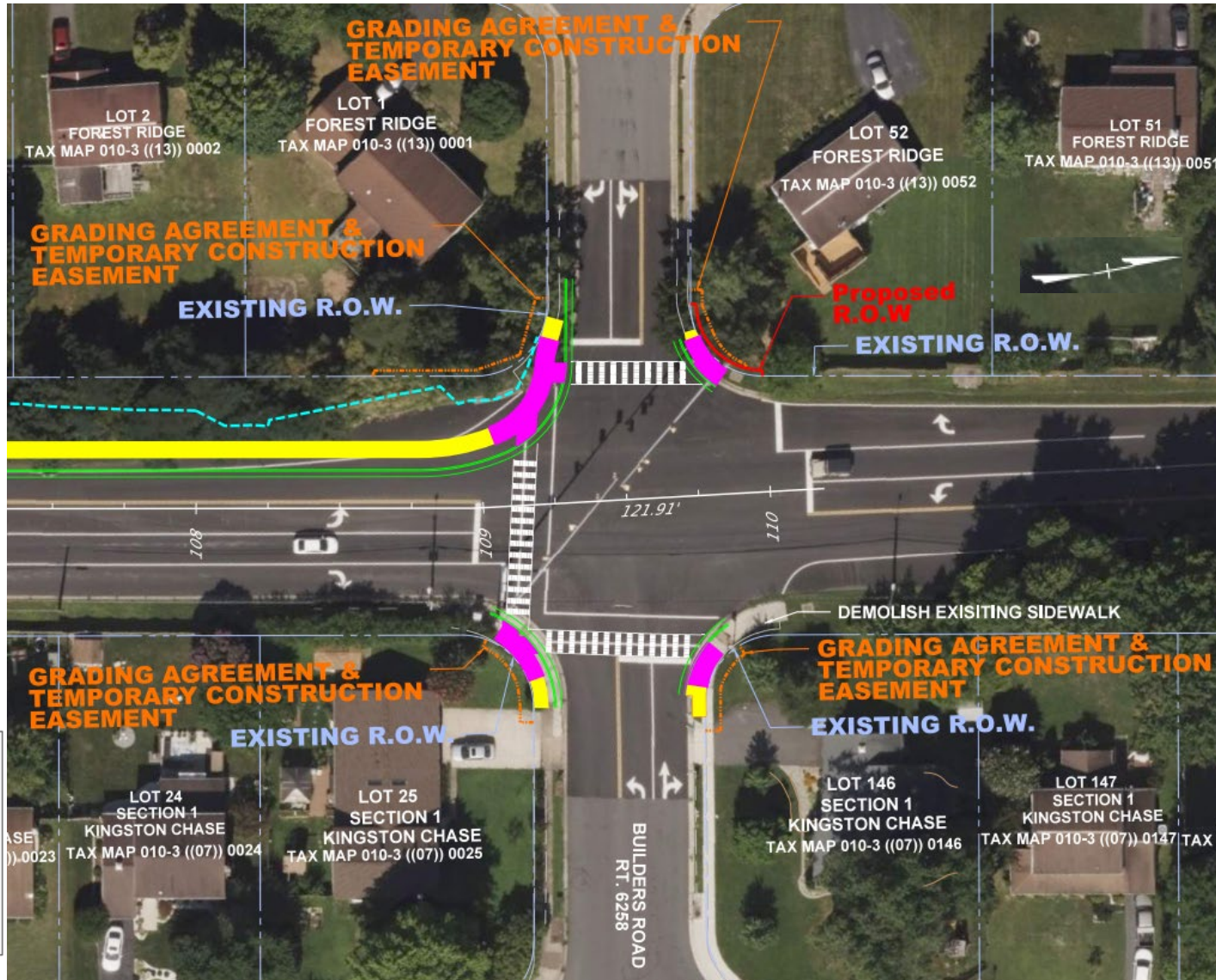
# Proposed Improvements at Elridge Lane

- ADA curb ramps



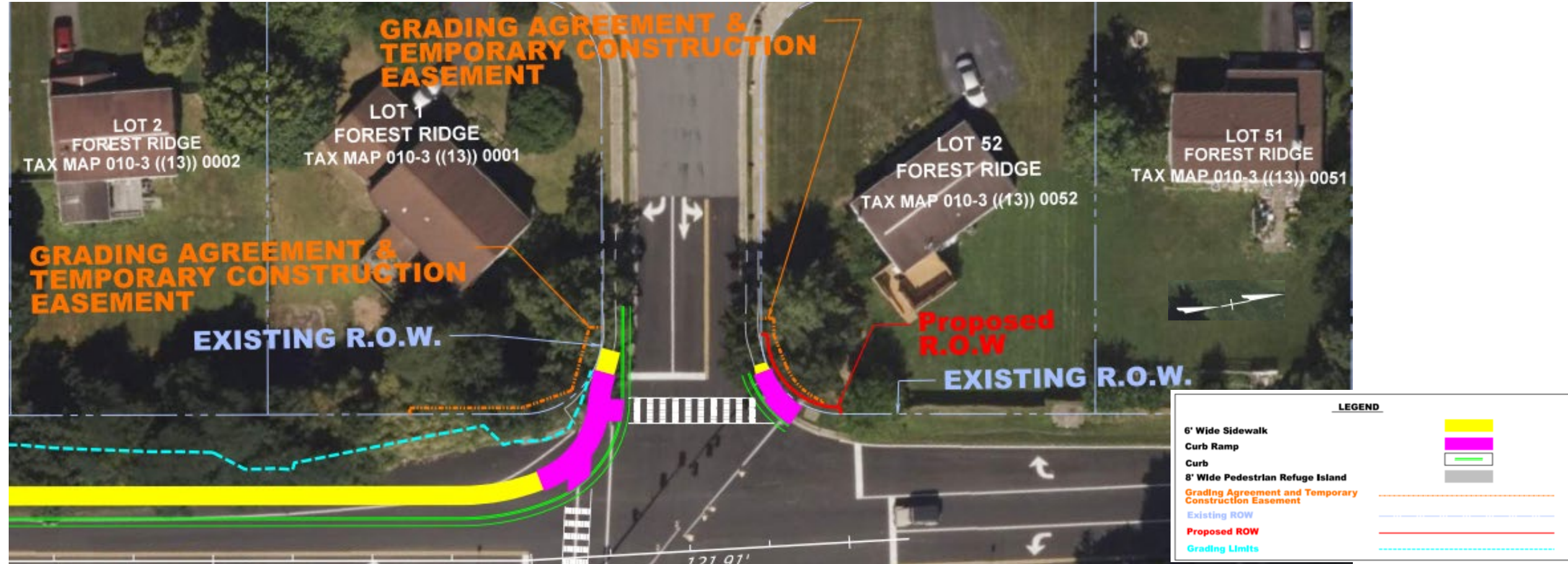

# Project Schedule and Estimated Cost

## Schedule

- Design
  - 60% Design – Completed in February 2025
  - 90% Design – Fall 2025
- Land Acquisition: Winter 2025 – Fall 2026
- Utility Relocation: Winter 2025 – Winter 2026
- Begin Construction: Spring 2027
- Construction Completion: Fall 2027

## Cost

- By Phase:
  - Preliminary Engineering \$453 K
  - Right-of-Way/Utility \$220 K
  - Construction \$880 K
- **Total project cost \$1.553 million.**
